### **[Day 01] Frankfurt → Prague (530 km)**

Make your own way to the meeting point area at Frankfurt am Main Hauptbahnhof (at least 15 minutes before the appointed time) for a scenic ride through classic German countryside en route to Czech Republic. You will arrive at Prague, one of Europe's most ornate cities in the early evening, ready to discover this charming capital city with its fairy-tale architecture the following morning.

### **[Day 02] Prague → Bratislava (330 km)**

Your Prague adventure begins with a spectacular walk along the Royal Route, following the traditional coronation path of Bohemian kings and queens, start from the top of Castle Hill in the Hradcany district that is famous for its views over the red-roofed old city. Visit Prague Castle, the historic seat of Bohemia royalty since the 9<sup>th</sup> century and home to the nation's presidents in recent times. Within the castle walls, explore the imposing gothic St. Vitus Cathedral, the Old Royal Palace, St. George's Basilica and along Golden Lane, an ancient thoroughfare lined with some colourful traditional buildings. Thereafter, enjoy a stroll across the iconic Charles Bridge which arches gracefully over the Vltava River, and through the winding alleys to the Old Town Square to see the City Hall as well as the Astronomical Clock, one of Prague's most well-known sights. After lunch, take a scenic ride from Prague to Bratislava, the Slovakian capital and home to another glorious old town. View the magnificent Bratislava Castle and St. Martin's Cathedral as you pass through the heart of the city by coach.

### **[Day 03] Bratislava → Budapest (200 km)**

In the morning, head across the border into Hungary. Budapest, its capital, is known as the Pearl of the Danube and is essentially two different cities joined together : Buda on the west of the river and Pest on the east, each with its own distinct characteristics. One of the best ways of exploring this unique location is by taking a river cruise, which many people choose to do. After a morning of activity, relax over lunch at Buda Palace and then, enjoy some free time to take a look at the exhibitions in the Budapest History Museum and Hungarian National Gallery or perhaps, do a spot of souvenir shopping. In the afternoon, explore both sides of the city on a cultural and historic tour. Highlights on the Buda side of Danube include the towered terrace of Fisherman's Bastion, the medieval Matthias Church and a walk up to the summit of Gellért Hill for panoramic views of the city; while over in Pest, the sights include the expansive Heroes' Square as well as Hungary's dramatic riverside Parliament Building. In the evening, you can choose to round off an eventful day with an optional dinner in the heart of Budapest where you can sample traditional dishes such as goose liver, goulash, duck leg and local wine, accompanied by Hungarian folkdance and music.

### **[Day 04] Budapest → Vienna (250 km)**

Leave Budapest on a short journey to another of Europe's grand capitals, Vienna, where you'll get to explore the Austrian city's resplendent palaces, striking churches as well as prestigious art museums. Your Vienna adventure begins at one of the city's most popular attractions, Schönbrunn Palace, the Rococo-style summer residence of the Habsburg dynasty, rulers of Europe and the church for many decades. After lunch in this refined setting, take a driving tour past many grand and famous buildings such as the City Hall, the Austrian Parliament, Hofburg Palace as well as Heroes' Square. In the afternoon, enjoy some free time shopping before adding the Wiener Staatsoper to your checklist of key Vienna buildings. Later, opt for dinner in the heart of the city or visit St. Stephen's Cathedral before enjoying a stroll in Stadtpark which is known for its range of sculptures, including the famous gilded bronze statue of Johann Strauss II. In the evening, we recommend the option of attending a Viennese Waltz Concert for an unforgettable experience of listening to some of the most celebrated compositions by the "Waltz King" Johann Strauss and Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, the boyhood genius who took Classicism to unparalleled heights of mastery as well as perfection.

### **[Day 05] Vienna → Salzburg → Munich (440 km)**

From Vienna, its' on to another Austrian gem, Salzburg. The city's beautiful historic centre is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, characterized by numerous baroque buildings, and is one of the most picturesque places in Europe. Salzburg is also famous for its musical heritage, both being the birthplace of Mozart and also as the filming locations of the hit musical "The Sound of Music". Enjoy an orientation tour to see from the outside of the house where Mozart was born and explore the picturesque old town further at your leisure, before heading across the German border to Munich in the afternoon.

### **[Day 06] Munich → Mount Titlis → Lucerne → Zurich (488 km)**

Today you will leave the big cities behind and head for one of the world's most famous mountain ranges - The Swiss Alps. The first destination is Engelberg, a stunning alpine resort. From here, you can opt to board a combination of gondolas over 3 stages that takes you to the summit of the impressive permanently snow-covered Mount Titlis. The last stage of the ascend features a five-minute trip on Titlis Rotair, the world's first revolving gondola that offers spectacular views of the valleys, glaciers, lakes and forests below as well as 360° vistas of the surrounding snow-covered mountain peaks. Appreciate the breath-taking panoramas at the sun terrace, explore the 150-metre-long Glacier Cave, or perhaps set your pulse racing with a walk across Titlis Cliff Walk, Europe's highest suspension bridge for phenomenal views into the abyss below. Thereafter, descend to the picturesque lakeside city of Lucerne, ideally situated in the historic and scenic heart of what many believe to be the "true" Switzerland - picture postcard mountains, lakes, alpine villages and meadows full of Edelweiss. Wander through the charming streets at your leisure, see the famous Lion Monument which Mark Twain once described as "the most mournful and moving piece of stone in the world", as well as enjoy a little shopping for some souvenirs like Swiss watches and fine chocolates, before continuing on to Zurich, a city with a reputation as one of the leading global financial centres.

**[Day 07] Zurich → Rhine Falls → Titisee → Frankfurt (450 km)**

The final day of the tour begins with a picture stop at the impressive Lake Zurich before moving on to Rhine Falls, Europe's biggest waterfall. Next, cross back into Germany and head towards Frankfurt via Black Forest, an ancient mountain range which is famous for its black firs as well as creepy folklore and mythical tales. See the beautiful lake Titisee where you can stop at one of the many lakeside cafés to enjoy some of the region's best Black Forest Cherry Gateaux. Home of the world-famous Cuckoo Clock, Titisee is an ideal place see a demonstration of how these magical mechanisms work as well as to pick up a few souvenirs from the local shops. Tour will conclude on arrival at Frankfurt Hauptbahnhof.
