[Day 01] Paris → Lucerne (650 km)

Make your own way to the meeting point area at Place d'Italie (at least 15 minutes before the appointed time) for a scenic journey across classic French countryside en route to mountainous Switzerland, passing through Basel which is located at the point where the Swiss, French and German borders meet. Upon arriving at the picturesque lakeside city of Lucerne which is nestled at the foot of the snow-capped Swiss Alps, enjoy a sightseeing tour of Lucerne's famous landmarks such as Chapel Bridge, the Water Tower as well as some wonderfully preserved Baroque and Gothic architecture. Rest of the day is free at leisure for you to further explore Lucerne or to do a spot of local shopping.

[Day 02] Lucerne → Milan → Venice (400 km)

In the morning, head south from Lucerne through spectacular Switzerland into northern Italy, where your first stop will be at Milan, the fashion capital of the world. Start with an orientation tour that will introduce you to the city's iconic sights such as the vast gothic Milan Cathedral as well as one of the world's oldest shopping mall, the 19th century Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II where one can wander among the boutique shops or perhaps, dine in one of its refined cafés. After enjoying the many delights of Milan, head over to Venice, another vintage Italian city.

[Day 03] Venice → Rome (550 km)

Spend the morning in the company of a knowledgeable local guide as you explore Venice, the magical city on water. Begin with a waterbus ride to San Marco Island, a memorable crossing of the lagoon that gives you a real taste of the city's charm as you approach the dreamy spires and distinctive waterside buildings. Once on the island, you will be led around some of Venice's best-known locations, beginning in the Piazza with the Basilica di San Marco, a stunning piece of Byzantine architecture; and followed by the legendary Bridge of Sighs which appears on many a postcard or picture of Venice and connects the old prison to the interrogation rooms in the Doge's Palace. Take the opportunity to also see some traditional Venetian craftwork at close quarters with a demonstration by Murano glassblowers, whose exquisite creations make excellent souvenirs. The ultimate Venice activity is of course, to ride through the warren of waterways on a gondola, and for most people this optional excursion is a must – step aboard, relax and enjoy this once-in-a-lifetime experience. Continue on to Rome later in the afternoon.

[Day 04] Rome → Vatican → Arezzo (280 km)

Your day in Rome starts with a visit to the smallest country in the world, The Vatican City, which lies at the heart of the Italian capital. Marvel at the exquisitely beautiful St. Peter's Basilica, arguably the most significant site in Christianity, has been present here for almost 1,700 years and contains a bewildering collection of paintings, frescoes and design crafted by some of humanity's most famous artist. Here, you can also choose to add on the optional Sistine Chapel Tour to view Michelangelo's famous painted ceiling. Next, visit the famous Trevi Fountain, a lavish Baroque showpiece where people flock to throw coins into the water – an action which is said to ensure that you'll return to the city again one day. After lunch, take a step further back in time as you visit Italy's unrivalled Roman relics. An optional guided tour of the Colosseum, built in AD72, is highly recommended. History comes to life as you imagine yourself witnessing gladiatorial combat inside the spectacular amphitheatre. Alternatively, you can walk at your leisure around the exterior to admire the façade of this ancient wonder. Get up close to the nearby Arch of Constantine which dates back to the 4th century AD, before enjoying some free time to further explore on your own. Sample the rich and creamy delights of "Gelato" Italian ice cream, visit the magnificent Basilique Santa Maria degli Angeli e dei Martiri near Piazza della Repubblica or do a bit of shopping at the Mitsukoshi Department Store before continuing on to Arezzo in the late evening.

[Day 05] Arezzo → Florence → Pisa → Genoa (250 km)

Your voyage of cultural discovery continues as you get to know Florence, the birthplace of Italian Renaissance and home to some fabulous architecture and fine art. Begin the day with a guided walk around Florence's many highlights such as Ponte Vecchio over the Arno, Piazza del Duomo as well as Giotto's Campanile, and passing by the Uffizi Gallery which contains one of the most notable art collections in Florence. Explore the city a little further on your own, do a spot of local shopping or watch the world go by from a streetside café; before travelling on to your next destination, Pisa. Here, you are free to wander, but be sure to have your camera ready for a shot of the iconic Leaning Tower, the famous bell tower in the "Square of Miracles" which also contains the centuries-old Cathedral and Baptistery.

[Day 06] Genoa → Monte Carlo → Nice → Cannes → Avignon (450 km)

A breath-taking drive along one of Europe's most famous stretches of Mediterranean coastline await as you say arrivederci to Italy and head over to the chic and beautiful Monaco, a small principality enclaved in France and is home to the famous Formula 1 Grand Prix. A walking tour here takes you to the grand Prince's Palace which was built in 1191 as a Genoese fortress, before continuing on to view the intricately designed Palais de Justice which was built using sea tuff stone and adorned with spiralling staircases, the cliffside Oceanographic Museum as well as the Saint Nicholas Cathedral where Princess Grace Kelly is buried. Travel a little further to visit the famous Fragonard Perfume Factory where you will be taken on a fascinating guided tour around this working factory before stopping for lunch at Nice to sample some excellent local cuisine and warm-hearted hospitality. Thereafter, continue on to Cannes where many a movie star has enjoyed the sweet smell of success. Be sure to take the opportunity to snap some photos of the Palais de Festival, home to the city's annual international film festival before transferring to Avignon Nord.

[Day 07] Avignon → Paris (700 km)

Take a well-earned rest today as you sit back and enjoy great views of the changing rural charms of the French countryside on the north bound journey back to Paris where the tour will conclude at Place d'Italie.




