## [Day 01] Paris → Reims → Luxembourg (420 km)

Make your own way to the meeting point area at Place d'Italie (at least 15 minutes before the appointed time) for a scenic journey through the rolling countryside of France to sacred town of Reims, the capital of Champagne region and an old province famous for its sparkling white wine. Enjoy seeing the historic attractions of the provincial capital, including The Cathedral of Reims where the coronations of French Kings took place from the 11<sup>th</sup> century onwards. History and traditions are equally evident at your next location: Luxembourg, the world's only remaining Grand Duchy. On arrival at Luxembourg City, enjoy a walking tour around Place de la Constitution and Pont Adolphe, before having time to further explore on your own.

# [Day 02] Luxembourg $\rightarrow$ Trier $\rightarrow$ Koblenz $\rightarrow$ Rüdesheim am Rhein $\rightarrow$ Frankfurt (400 km)

Head across another European border into Trier, Germany's oldest city that was known as Roma Segunda, the "Second Rome", when it became one of the administrative capital of the Western Roman Empire. You will have the chance to see from the outside of Karl Marx Haus, the birthplace of the influential philosopher which now functions as a museum. Your walking tour then takes you into the centre of Trier to see the city's impressive cathedral where the celebrated Holy Robe – said to be the tunic of Christ – is preserved and occasionally displayed; as well as Porta Nigra, the best-preserved Roman city gate north of the Alps. Continue on to Koblenz which strategically located at the confluence of the Rhine and Moselle Rivers. Indulge in a relaxing lunch alongside the water and perhaps, enjoy an optional Rhine Riverboat Cruise (available seasonally from early April to late October only). Drive through the wine-making town of Rüdesheim and on to Frankfurt am Main to discover the delights of Römerberg, a charming plaza with a distinctive medieval town hall as its centrepiece.

## [Day 03] Frankfurt → Bonn → Cologne → Amsterdam (500 km)

Leave Frankfurt on a leisurely drive north-west to Bonn, the capital of the former "West Germany" from 1949 to 1990. Discover the city's secrets on an orientation stroll through its streets, walking past highlights such as the Rococo-fronted Town Hall as well as Ludwig Van Beethoven Haus, a museum dedicated to the much-loved composer. Continue on to Cologne to visit the city's glorious Gothic Cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Rest of the afternoon is free at leisure for you to further explore Cologne, to do a spot of local shopping or just simply relax with a suitably refreshing German brew. After lunch, the day is rounded off with a drive into The Netherlands.

#### [Day 04] Amsterdam → Zaanse Schans → Amsterdam (50 km)

A day of delights begins with a countryside excursion to the village of Zaanse Schans where you'll get to sample at close quarters some of the things that The Netherlands is traditionally famous for – visit a Wooden Shoes Factory, Cheese Farm as well as enjoy a photo stop at one of the well-preserved iconic Windmills around the historic village. Thereafter, head back to the cosmopolitan as your journey takes you back to Amsterdam for a visit to a well-known diamond factory which uses unique cutting techniques since the 16<sup>th</sup> century. Rest of the day is free at leisure for you to enjoy an optional pre-dinner canal cruise or explore the bustling Dam Square.

\*\* From mid-March to mid-May, the tour will also visit Keukenhof Garden, a 32-hectare seasonal exhibition of beautifully coloured and scented displays of spring flowers – most notably, millions of tulips!

#### [Day 05] Amsterdam → Brussels → Paris (500 km)

In the morning, head south across the border into Brussels, the Belgian capital and political centre of the European Union. Along the way, stop for a photo at the distinctive Atomium, a cell-shaped structure of stainless steel spheres and tubes built for the 1958 World's Fair. In the centre of Brussels itself, enjoy an orientation tour of the exquisite Grand Place as well as see the famous impish Manneken Pis. After some free time, during which you can try some mouth-watering Belgian delights, continue on south again across the French border and on to the bright lights of Paris.

## [Day 06] Paris → Versailles → Paris (60 km)

Your Parisian adventures get off to a spectacular start with as you enjoy guided tour around one of the world's most celebrated cities. See the iconic Arc de Triomphe, an imposing monument that sits near the western end of the avenue and commemorates the fallen of the Revolutionary and Napoleonic wars; Drive along the famous Champs Élysées to the Place de la Concorde, where the royals and many aristocracy members were guillotined there during the Revolution; Take in another significant historical building as you head over to L'Hôtel National des Invalides where Napoleon's tomb is located; followed by a photo stop at the legendary wrought iron lattice Eiffel Tower. Take time to explore the surrounding neighbourhood or perhaps, ascent to the top floor of Eiffel Tower for a truly magical and unforgettable views over the city. Thereafter, travel through the Parisian suburbs to the splendid Palace of Versailles. Built as a hunting lodge by Louis XIII, the vast regal château was the residence of the royal family until the start of the revolution in 1789. Evening is free at leisure for you to enjoy one of our optional Paris evening shows.

#### [Day 07] Paris

The second day of your Parisian experience begins with a visit to The Louvre, one of the world's greatest art museums. Enjoy the sights of famous masterpieces, including the Venus de Milo, Winged Victory of Samothrace (also called Nike of Samothrace) as well as Leonardo da Vinci's best-known work, Mona Lisa. Opt for a guided gallery tour which will enhance your experience and allow you to browse through hundreds of works in just a few hours. After an exhilarating morning walking the gallery corridors, you can opt for a leisurely cruise along the River Seine, a great sightseeing option that offers splendid views of other iconic Parisian landmarks such as Notre-Dame Cathedral or Pont Alexandre III; before over to explore the area surrounding the Palais Garnier, Paris' Opera House. Enjoy a little shopping at Galeries Lafayette, one of the world's most celebrated department stores and perhaps, opt for a 4-course French Dinner and Show experience. Tour will conclude at Paris' Opera House.
