Day 01 _____ / Sapporo / Noboribetsu (Hotel Dinner)

Upon your arrival at Chitose International Airport, our local representative will be waiting there to welcome you and start the sightseeing tour to **【Ainu Museum Poroto Kotan】** - also known as "Shiraoi Ainu Museum", is one of the country's best museums about the Ainu, the indigenous people of northern Japan. Then continue your journey to **【Toya Sairo Observation Deck】** - This is an observation deck which commands the whole view of Lake Toya. Thereafter proceed to the **【Hell Valley】** - also known as "Jigokudani" of the local people, it is a valley with hot steam and volcanic gases gushing out all over the place. The spring water here is the main source for the downhill Noboribetsu Onsen. The spectacular views can be enjoyed from a high-rise observation

Day 02 Noboribetsu / Hakodate (Breakfast, Japanese Lunch, Hotel/Japanese Dinner)

After breakfast, travel to Hakodate which is located north of Japan, and it is the largest city in southern Hokkaido. Start the tour by visiting the **【Seaweed Museum】**, where you can learn how Konbu is grown and processed in Hokkaido. Thereafter visit the **【Hakodate Meijikan】** it was formerly the Hakodate Post Office which was built in 1911 but has now converted into a much-loved shopping mall with a cafe, glassworks shop, music box shop and more. Tourists can create their own unique glassware and try sand blasting. Then continue to visit **【Fort Goryokaku】** - is a massive, star shaped, Western style citadel, which was built in the last years of the Edo Period for the defense of Hakodate against the imperialist threat posed by the Western powers. You can access the observation deck of the nearby Goryokaku Tower to enjoy the whole view of this huge fortress. In the evening, take a cable car to **【Mount Hakodate】** to enjoy the world rank No.3 night view after rivaling with Hong Kong and Naples.

Day 03 Hakodate / Sapporo (Breakfast, Japanese Lunch, Japanese Dinner)

After breakfast, proceed to **【Fresh Seafood market】** - where you will find various kind of fresh local seafood such as the flower crab, sea urchins, salmon, tuna, etc. Thereafter visit the **【Mount Usu】** and **【Mount Showa shinzan】** - Mount Usu is an active stratovolcano in the Shikotsu Toya National Park, it is one of most active volcanoes in Japan, and right next to Mount Usu is one of Japan's newest mountains, the mountain was formed in 1943 - Showa Shinzan. Then continue to **【Showa Shinzan Bear Farm】** where you will find almost 100 brown bears around the size of 2 meters are being bred here. You can buy cookies and apples and try bears feeding. Then continue to visit **【Kitahiroshima Mitsui Outlet】**, this is a must-visit for visitors to Hokkaido! You will find many famous brands products including cosmetic etc. Then, return to Sapporo to visit the **【Odori Park】**. The firebreak became Shiribeshi Dori, which was renamed Odori. Enjoy some free time shopping at **【Sapporo Underground Shopping Malls Aurora Town】** then have a photo stop at **【Sapporo Clock Tower】** a symbol of Sapporo. The building was constructed during the early period of Sapporo's development in 1878 as a drill hall of the Sapporo Agricultural College.

Day 04 Sapporo / Otaru / Sapporo (Breakfast, Buffet BBQ + 3 Kinds Crab Dinner)

After breakfast, stop by the **【Okurayama Ski Jump Stadium】** which hosted a number of winter sports events including 1972 Winter Olympics, the hilltop observatory can overlooking the city panorama. (*Mid December to March will be replace with Otaru Tenguyama Ski Resort - ski equipment own expenses*) **【Otaru Tenguyama】** is really suitable for beginner and intermediate skiers and snowboarders. Thereafter, visit the famous **【Shiroi Koibito Park】**. It is a fantastic place based on the ideals of deliciousness, fun and stories of sweets from a bygone era. The park not only consist of Shiroi Koibito Factory where this well-known Hokkaido confectionery is produced, it also has a cafe to allow visitors to savor Ishiya's original sweets. Thereafter proceed to **【Otaru Canal】** - 1140m in length and 40m in width, is one of the oldest canal, about 120 years history. Many Japanese drama scenes were taken here. Lastly, visit the famous **【Otaru Music Box Museum】** and **【Otaru Glass Factory】**.



Day 05 Sapporo (Breakfast, Japanese Lunch, Shabu Shabu Dinner)

After breakfast, visit the 【Hokkaido Jingu】 is a Shinto shrine sited in Maruyama Park. The Hokkaido Shrine enshrines four kami including the soul of the Emperor Meiji. (*Mid December to March will be replace with Snow Mobile Land Sapporo - Snowmobile rides on own expenses*) 【Snowmobile Land Sapporo】 - explore the Sapporo's frozen hills by snowmobile offers an unusual experience of excitement and solitude. You can stop in the quiet winter landscapes and great views of Sapporo, or fulfil your need for speed by tearing down open trails. Tours range from 60 minutes to 90 minutes. After that return to Sapporo to visit 【Former Hokkaidō Government Office】 , the Baroque architecture building was built in 1888. The building is said to have modelled on the capitals of Maryland and Massachusetts. It is the equivalent of a city hall or town hall and houses the archives of Hokkaido. Then continue to visit 【Sapporo Beer Museum】 - is the birthplace of beer in Japan. Sapporo Beer, one of the oldest and most popular beer brands in the country. The museum also will introduce the history of beer in Japan and the process of beer making. Enjoy some free time shopping at 【Tanuki Koji Shopping Arcade】 and 【Sapporo Ramen Yokocho】 - is a famous ramen alley in "Susukino", and known as the birthplace of miso ramen. This Ramen Alley now has 17 ramen restaurants. In the evening, visit the 【Susukino】 - It is one of the major red-light districts in Japan; the district is congested with many restaurants, bars, hotels, and pub. At night, you can see a variety of bright and dazzling neon signs.

Day 06 Sapporo / _____ (Breakfast)

After breakfast, free at leisure until it is time for your transfer back to the airport for your onwards journey.
