Sample itinerary :

Day 01 _____ / SIEM REAP (No meal)

Upon your arrival at Siem Reap International Airport, you will be met by our local representative and thereafter, transfer to your selected hotel for check-in. Rest of the day is free at leisure for you to explore the city.

Day 02 SIEM REAP (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, begin the day exploring the grounds of Angkor Wat, an UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the "Seven Wonders of the World". Constructed during the first half of the 12th century and encompassing an area of about 400 acres, this awe-inspiring temple is the largest and the best-preserved monument within the ancient city that was the epicentre of the Khmer empire that once ruled most of Southeast Asia. Thereafter, continue on to The South Gate of Angkor Thom, the last capital of the Khmer Empire. Explore the temples inside the walls of the "Great City" such as Bayon, Baphoun, Terrace of the Elephants as well as the Terrace of the Leper King; and followed by a small circuit tour of Ta Prohm, a temple with jungle-like atmosphere with a combination of giant trees and extensive roots growing out of the ruins; Banteay Kdei, meaning "Citadel of Chambers" – a fascinating maze of dilapidated chambers that have been home to an active monastery at multiple time periods since its construction in the 12th century, up until the 1960s; as well as the adjacent Srah Srang - a picturesque baray measuring 700 by 350 metres that was dug out during the reign of King Rajendravarmen II in the mid-10th century and served as an ablution pool for ritual washings. Later, take a short hike to the top of Pre Rup, a stepped pyramidal temple-mountain, for a fabulous view of sunset over Angkor Wat and its surrounding rice fields as well as forested countryside; before relaxing and unwinding while enjoying a dinner with Khmer Traditional Show.

Day 03 SIEM REAP (Breakfast, Picnic Lunch)

After breakfast, journey approximately 40 kilometres Northeast of Siem Reap to Phnom Kulen National Park. Literally the "Mountain of Lychees", it is believed to be the birthplace of the ancient Khmer Empire and is considered to be the most sacred mountain in Cambodia. Wind through some spectacular tropical jungle scenery to emerge on the plateau, visit Preah Ang Thom, a 16th century Buddhist monastery which houses a massive reclining Buddha carved into the sandstone boulder upon which it is built. At the base of the temple sits the famous Kbal Spean, more commonly referred to in English as the "River of a Thousand Lingas". Believed to date back to the 11th century, the riverbed has been elaborately etched with several hundreds of Lingas as well as Yonis while depictions of Hindu deities dotted the area along the river. Take a dip and cool off at one of the waterfalls, enjoy a picnic lunch before returning to the city for a little shopping at T Galleria by DFS – Cambodia's biggest duty-free luxury department store that offers 300 leading international brands alongside a selection of locally handcrafted artisan products. After lunch, rest of the day is free at leisure for your own activities.

Day 04 SIEM REAP / _____ (Breakfast)

After breakfast, free at leisure until it is time for your transfer back to the airport for your onwards journey.
