Sample itinerary :

Day 01 _____ / SIEM REAP (No meal)

Upon your arrival at Siem Reap International Airport, you will be met by our local representative and thereafter, transfer to your selected hotel for check-in. Rest of the day is free at leisure for you to explore the city.

Day 02 SIEM REAP (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, begin the day exploring the grounds of Angkor Wat, an UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the "Seven Wonders of the World". Constructed during the first half of the 12th century and encompassing an area of about 400 acres, this awe-inspiring temple is the largest and the best-preserved monument within the ancient city that was the epicentre of the Khmer empire that once ruled most of Southeast Asia. Thereafter, continue on to The South Gate of Angkor Thom, the last capital of the Khmer Empire. Explore the temples inside the walls of the "Great City" such as Bayon, Baphoun, Terrace of the Elephants as well as the Terrace of the Leper King; and followed by a small circuit tour of Ta Prohm, a temple with jungle-like atmosphere with a combination of giant trees and extensive roots growing out of the ruins; Banteay Kdei, meaning "Citadel of Chambers" – a fascinating maze of dilapidated chambers that have been home to an active monastery at multiple time periods since its construction in the 12th century, up until the 1960s; as well as the adjacent Srah Srang - a picturesque baray measuring 700 by 350 metres that was dug out during the reign of King Rajendravarmān II in the mid-10th century and served as an ablution pool for ritual washings. Later, take a short hike to the top of Pre Rup, a stepped pyramidal temple-mountain, for a fabulous view of sunset over Angkor Wat and its surrounding rice fields as well as forested countryside; before relaxing and unwinding while enjoying a dinner with Khmer Traditional Show.

Day 03 SIEM REAP / PHNOM PENH (Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, journey 16 kilometres from Siem Reap to visit the Chong Kneas Floating Village at Tonlé Sap – one of the largest freshwater lakes in Asia. The Tonlé Sap is unusual for two reasons - its flow changes direction twice a year, and the portion that forms the lake expands and shrinks dramatically with the seasons. Take a ride on a traditional wooden boat and experience the human occupations at the edges of the lake, the towering stilted houses, huge fish traps, etc... Thereafter, enjoy a little shopping at T Galleria by DFS – Cambodia's biggest duty-free luxury department store that offers 300 leading international brands alongside a selection of locally handcrafted artisan products. After lunch, embark on a 6-hour journey to Phnom Penh. Upon your arrival, transfer to your selected hotel for check-in and thereafter, rest of the evening is free at leisure for you to explore the city.

Day 04 PHNOM PENH (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, proceed on a sightseeing tour around the city visiting the Royal Palace - one of the impressive and colourful Khmer-style Palaces which was built in 1866 by the predecessors of King Norodom; Silver Pagoda that displays plenty of Buddha Statues that are decorated and made with diamonds, emeralds, gold as well as silver; Toul Sleng Genocide Museum which was used by the Khmer Rouge as a detention as well as torture centre in the late 1970s; and followed by a little shopping at Phsar Toul Tom Pong – a traditional Cambodian market that is often referred to as the Russian Market and offers a large selection of handicrafts, woodcarvings, silk scarves, jewellery, musical instruments, etc... After lunch, continue on to visit Wat Phnom - the birthplace of the capital; and thereafter, journey approximately 15 kilometres South-West of Phnom Penh to Choeng Ek Killing Fields. This place is a chilling reminder of the brutalities of the genocidal Khmer Rouge regime. Along the way, enjoy a photo stop at Independence Monument, a lotus-shaped stupa built to commemorate the country's independence from the French regime and also serve as a memorial to Cambodian patriots who died for their country.

Day 05 PHNOM PENH / _____ (Breakfast)

After breakfast, free at leisure until it is time for your transfer to Phnom Penh International Airport for your onwards journey.
