Sample itinerary :

Day 01 _____ / JEJU

(Dinner)

Upon your arrival at Jeju International Airport and after clearing customs, you will be met by our local representative and thereafter, begin your trip with a visit to Teddy Bear Museum which houses an impressive collection of toy bears, from soft cuddly childhood favourites to historic artefacts as well as from lifelike replicas to kitsch novelties; followed by a sightseeing tour around Yongduam Rock – an unusual lava formation that resembles a dragon head with open mouth soaring 100 meters above sea level, creating harmony with the deep violet-blue sea; and a brief photo stop at Dokkaebi-ro or Mysterious Road – see a curious phenomenon where objects as well as liquid appear to roll or flow uphill instead of down.

Day 02 JEJU

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, start the day with a sightseeing tour around the eastern side of the island visiting UNESCO World Natural Heritage Site Seongsan Ilchulbong - one of the most scenic landmarks of Jeju Island to view magnificent sunrises; Seongeup Folk Village – a uniquely preserved village at the foot of Mount Halla that has retained age old traditions where its residents still live behind stone courtyard walls in thatched-roof lava-wall homes; PLAY KPOP Museum – the nation's largest virtual reality K-pop experience hall where visitors can attend vivid and exciting holographic concerts, enjoy a date with their favourite star or even become a K-pop performer; as well as Camellia Hill – the largest camellia arboretum in East Asia and is home to over 6,000 trees from 500 species of camellias as well as a variety of other seasonal plants such as palm trees, cherry blossoms, azalea, hydrangea and wildflowers. Along the way, enjoy a unique horseback riding experience while appreciating Jeju's natural wonders; as well as enjoy a little shopping for some duty-free health supplements at the National Ginseng Outlet.

Day 03 JEJU / UDO / JEJU

(Breakfast, Dinner)

After breakfast, soak in the gentle breeze and perhaps, enjoy the fantastic ocean view while sipping a cup of hot coffee (beverages are optional, on own expense) at Café Aewol Monsant - a beautiful café with pivoting mirror-glass door and volcanic stone walls, rumoured to be owned by G-Dragon of well-known boy band Big Bang. Thereafter, head over to Seongsanhang Port Passenger Ferry Terminal for a 15-minutes ferry ride to Udo, literally "Cow Island", thanks to its shape, resembling that of a cow lying down. Your adventure begins with a visit to Udo's dramatic Huhaeseokbyeok, a unique 20-metre high vertical cliff which has well aligned faults and looking like neatly stacked rock pieces; followed by Geommeolle Beach on the eastern side of Udo, famed for its small but beautiful black sand beach which leads to a cave encompassed by large boulders. Here, visitors can spot Jeju Island's widely celebrated Haenyeo or female divers along the coast as well as sports enthusiasts seeking fun water activities along the seashores. The next stop after Geommeolle Beach is Biyang Island, an interesting mini island with black pebble beach, connected to Udo via a land bridge with its own lighthouse and pretty views out to the sea as well as of Udobong from afar. Free at leisure for you to further explore Udo until it is time to return to Cheonjin Port for your ferry ride back to Jeju.

Day 04 JEJU

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, visit O'Sulloc Tea Museum, a contemporary-looking building that is shaped like a giant teacup, to gain insight on Korea's traditional tea culture. The museum's exhibits illustrate the history of tea drinking in Korea and display hundreds of tea wares from around the world. Thereafter, experience the thrill of getting lost inside Maze Land – a sprawling attraction that boasts the world's longest stone labyrinth, measuring approximately 5.3 kilometres in length. Spend the afternoon shopping for some duty-free skin care products at a Cosmetics Specialty Shop as well as health supplements at a "HD-1 Tab.Gold" Specialty Shop; and enjoy a dose of Korean culture by learning how to make Kimbap, a quintessential Korean packed lunch made of seasoned white rice with a variety of fillings, rolled up in roasted seaweed and served in bite-size slices OR Kimchi, a traditional fermented dish which an absolute necessity in every Korean meal; as well as experience wearing the Korean Traditional Costume "Hanbok"; before heading over to Tapdong Shopping Street, a bustling entertainment and shopping area with some great shops exclusively selling local handicrafts, modern fashion and accessories as well as the sought-after Korean beauty products.

Day 05 JEJU / _____

(Breakfast)

After breakfast, if time permits, enjoy some last-minute shopping at the bustling Jeju Dongmun Traditional Market – the island's largest and permanent market offering diverse items from freshly caught seafood and fresh produce to local delicacies, souvenirs and casual apparels; until it is time to head over to a local product shop for some local delicacies before continuing back to the airport for your onwards journey.
