# Sample itinerary:

Day 01 \_\_\_\_\_ / INCHEON / CHUNCHEON / SOKCHO

(Lunch, Dinner)

Upon your arrival at Incheon International Airport and after clearing customs, please proceed to the Meeting Point area at "Gate 8" on the 1st Floor. Our local representative will be waiting there to welcome you. Begin your trip with a journey approximately 100 kilometres East of Incheon to visit Naminara Republic, a tiny half-moon shaped island located in Chuncheon that was formed as a result of seasonal rain as well as the construction of the Cheongpyeong Dam. The famous "first kiss" as well as other important scenes such as the beautiful tree-lined paths from the 2002 Korean drama "Winter Sonata" was filmed here. Thereafter, continue on to Soyanggang Skywalk, an observatory facility set up on Uiamho Lake with a 156-meter-long transparent walking path, laid 7.5 meters above the river that offers visitors a walk-on-water-like experience; before heading over to explore Edelweiss Swiss Theme Park, a charming Swiss-theme cultural village which emulates the architectural visage of some of Switzerland's iconic small towns. Surrounded by lush greenery and vibrant flower-laden gardens, the blissful landscapes here are absolutely postcard-worthy. Visitors can also delight in the exciting experience programmes held at the numerous museum present.

#### Day 02 SOKCHO / SEOUL

# (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, enjoy a walking tour around Seoraksan National Park, one of Korea's most beautiful mountain areas that boast numerous valleys well-known for their spring blossoms and fall foliage. Situated on the slopes of Seoraksan, explore Sinheungsa, the head temple of the Jogye Order of Korean Buddhism. Thereafter, brace yourself for a wondrous and exhilarating experience learning to ski (exclude ski equipment & ski suit, rental on own expenses), take your time to master the strokes, frolic in the powdery white snow or simply build your own snowman!

# Day 03 SEOUL (Breakfast)

After breakfast, start the day with a sightseeing tour around the city visiting N Seoul Tower which is perched at the highest point of Namsan. Take a look at the safety fence which is covered with thousands of padlocks - symbols of love fastened there by young couples; as well as enjoy the panoramic views of Seoul and its surrounding areas from the viewing platforms (observatory admission is optional, on own expenses) at the 237-meters tall communication tower. Thereafter, continue on to visit Namsangol Hanok Village – a collection of five traditional Korean houses reflecting the different walks of life from the Joseon Dynasty era that was recovered from different parts of the city and relocated to the northern foot of Namsan; followed by Tongin Market – a small arcade style traditional market that was established in 1941 and is famed for its "Dosirak" Café that gives visitors the experience of exchanging traditional brass coins to build their own Korean Lunchbox. In the afternoon, enjoy a dose of Korean culture by learning how to make Kimbap, a quintessential Korean packed lunch made of seasoned white rice with a variety of fillings, rolled up in roasted seaweed and served in bite-size slices; and experience wearing the Korean Traditional Costume "Hanbok; before heading over to explore Hongdae Shopping Street – a sea of little shops and ever-expanding boutiques near Hongik University that is popular for indie fashion, cute cafés, street art and hanging out till all hours of the night.

#### Day 04 SEOUL

### (Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, visit Gyeongbokgung which was built at the beginning of the Joseon Dynasty by its founder King Taejo and serves as the principal palace until it was burnt down during the Japanese invasion in 1592. It lay in ruins for nearly 300 years until it was rebuilt in 1865 during the reign of King Gojong, the first emperor of Korea. Thereafter, enjoy a brief photo stop at Cheong Wa Dae, the Presidential Office and Private Residence which is also known as the "Blue House" before continuing on to the nearby Gwanghwamun Square – a national landmark located in the heart of Seoul with statues of King Sejong the Great and Admiral Yi Sunshin, the popular 12·23 fountain, Waterways of History as well as a sculpture of Haechi, the symbolic icon of Seoul. Spend the afternoon shopping for duty-free health supplements at either "HD-1 Tab.Gold" or Red Pine Oil Specialty Store, National Ginseng Outlet as well some duty-free goods at Lotte Duty Free; before heading over to Myeongdong, one of Seoul's main shopping districts featuring mid-to-high priced retail stores as well as international brands.

# Day 05 SEOUL / INCHEON /

# (Breakfast)

After breakfast, if time permits, head over to discover the quaint neighbourhood of Insadong which is filled with antique shops, boutique galleries, handicraft shops, bookstores, traditional teahouses, etc...; as well as enjoy some last-minute shopping at a local product shop for some local delicacies before continuing back to the airport for your onwards journey.
