## Sample itinerary :

### Day 01 \_\_\_\_\_ / BANGKOK

**(No meal)**

Upon arrival at Suvarnabhumi Airport and after clearing customs, please proceed to the Meeting Point area at Exit B (Gate 06) or Exit C (Gate 10) of the arrival hall at Level 2. For passengers arriving at Don Muang Airport, please proceed to Door 3 at the Arrival Hall. Our local representative will be there to welcome and transfer you to your selected hotel. The rest of the day is free at leisure for you to explore the city.

### Day 02 BANGKOK / DAMNOEN SADUAK / MAEKLONG / HUA HIN **(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)**

After an early breakfast, journey approximately 90 kilometres West of Bangkok to visit Damnoen Saduak on a long tail boat (additional paddle boat ride is optional, at your own expense) one of the most famous floating markets near Bangkok. This vibrant market features many colourfully clad merchants in small boats laden with fruits and vegetables paddling along congested canals. It's a very attractive place for tourist to see this old style and traditional way of selling and buying goods. Thereafter, continue on to "Talad Rom Hoop" MaeKlong Railway Market in Samut Songkhram Province. As its name in Thai which literally translates to "Umbrella Pull-down Market" suggests, part of the market is situated on the railway. Eight times daily, the market will come to a standstill while the vendors hastily scoop up their baskets of goods that are lying over the railway tracks and hold on to the poles supporting their low-hanging awnings or umbrellas to make way for the trains to pass. As soon as the last coach rolls through, the market will unfold and within seconds, spring back to life as if nothing has happened. After lunch, enjoy some free time exploring Camel Republic – a mini zoo cum amusement park with an array of fun rides and features Moroccan-inspired architecture, complete with Persian tiles as well as golden spires << rides and activities at Camel Republic are optional, at own expense >>; as well as Maruekhathaiyawan (Mrigadayavan) Palace. Often referred to as "The Palace of Love and Hope", this Thai-Victorian summer seaside getaway was constructed in the early 1920s during the reign of King Rama VI using golden teak from the demolished Hat Chao Samran Palace. Set on a vast manicured landscape and fronting the idyllic Cha Am Beach, this candy-coloured mansion comprises three one-storey pavilions with lots of verandas, latticework and high ceilings as well as covered boardwalk, on more than 1,000 raised pillars. In the evening, enjoy a stroll around Hua Hin Night market for a fascinating insight into the local people's lifestyle where one can find countless stalls selling freshly cooked local delicacies as well as an overwhelming variety of local handicrafts, souvenirs as well as clothing.

### Day 03 HUA HIN **(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)**

After breakfast, start the day with a visit to Hua Hin Hills Vineyard, the seaside resort town's first boutique vineyard. Nestled on the verdant mountain valley approximately 45 kilometres west of Hua Hin and built on the site of a former elephant corral, the terrain is conducive to the cultivation of grapes and production of award-winning "New Latitude Wines". Continue on to Hua Hin Railway Station - one of Thailand's oldest railway stations with a long cultural heritage and unique architecture. Its splendid Royal Waiting Room used to be a royal pavilion at Sanam Chan Palace during the reign of King Rama IV which was relocated and rebuilt at Hua Hin Railway Station in 1968. Thereafter, head over to immerse in the charming and romantic ambience of The Venezia - a unique lifestyle shopping destination with over 360 stores offering a variety of fashion and accessories as well as trendy restaurants and pubs. This 73,600m<sup>2</sup> Venice-inspired theme shopping and attraction village also feature replicas of Venice's most symbolic landmarks such as The Bell Tower of San Marco, Piazza San Marco, Trevi Fountain as well as a 200-meter Grand Canal with the iconic Gondola ride that navigates around the village. After lunch, enjoy the afternoon exploring PlearnWan - a vintage village containing two-storey wooden complexes of stylized old-fashioned shop houses, a reminiscent of those that once made up the Thai-Chinese neighbourhoods of Bangkok and Hua Hin. Wander around the classic charms of old Hua Hin and enjoy a little shopping for some local delicacies, vintage merchandise, retro souvenirs, etc...

### Day 04 HUA HIN / BANGKOK **(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)**

After breakfast, embark on your return journey back to Bangkok and on arrival, enjoy a sightseeing tour around Bangkok, starting with a visit to Wat Indraviharn. Also known as The Standing Buddha Temple, this temple is known for its huge and soaring 32-metres (100 feet) high 24-carat gold standing Buddha image called Luang Pho To, which was constructed in the reign of King Rama IV. Thereafter, continue on to the west bank of the Chao Phraya River to visit the famous Wat Arun (temple admission is optional, on own expense). Better known as the Temple of Dawn, it has an imposing spire (Prang) of over 70 meters high, beautifully decorated with tiny pieces of coloured glass and chinese porcelain placed delicately into intricate patterns. After lunch, visit Bangkok Gems Gallery - the world's biggest jewellery store to see the vast selection of gems and jewellery; Bangkok's Finest Genuine Leather Shop where you will learn how to tell the difference between real and fake leather; as well as a local bee farm which offers a wide selection of natural honey products. Evening is free at leisure for your own activities.

### Day 05 BANGKOK / \_\_\_\_\_ **(Breakfast)**

After breakfast, free at leisure until it is time for your transfer back to the airport for your onwards journey.
