## Sample itinerary :

### Day 01 \_\_\_\_\_ / BANGKOK (No meal)

Upon arrival at Suvarnabhumi Airport and after clearing customs, please proceed to the Meeting Point area at Exit B (Gate 06) or Exit C (Gate 10) of the arrival hall at Level 2. For passengers arriving at Don Muang Airport, please proceed to Door 3 at the Arrival Hall. Our local representative will be there to welcome and transfer you to your selected hotel. The rest of the day is free at leisure for you to explore the city.

### Day 02 BANGKOK / PATTAYA (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, start the day with a visit to Wat Indraviharn. Also known as The Standing Buddha Temple, this temple is known for its huge and soaring 32-metres (100 feet) high 24-carat gold standing Buddha image called Luang Pho To, which was constructed in the reign of King Rama IV. Thereafter, continue on to the west bank of the Chao Phraya River to visit the famous Wat Arun (temple admission is optional, on own expense). Better known as the Temple of Dawn, it has an imposing spire (Prang) of over 70 meters high, beautifully decorated with tiny pieces of coloured glass and chinese porcelain placed delicately into intricate patterns. Next, visit Bangkok Gems Gallery - the world's biggest jewellery store to see the vast selection of gems and jewellery; Bangkok's Finest Genuine Leather Shop where you will learn how to tell the difference between real and fake leather; as well as a local bee farm which offers a wide selection of natural honey products; before departing for Pattaya with enroute visit to Sriracha Tiger Zoo - a unique tiger zoo in the region and home to over 400 Royal Bengal Tigers. Continue on to visit Khao Chi Chan which is also known as Buddha Mountain and features a line-etched image of Buddha engraved onto the face of a limestone cliff in 1996 to commemorate King Bhumibol's golden jubilee, his majesty's 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of his accession to the throne; and followed by Thai Thani Arts & Cultural Village - a unique attraction featuring the culture and traditions of old Thailand. Experience the delightful charms of the Thai way of life in the past; admire the elegant architecture of various styles of ethnic dwellings from the four regions of Thailand; as well as taste your way through a diverse selection of delicacies from around the country; before heading over to "Art in Paradise" - Pattaya's first ever three-dimensional illusion art museum that spread over an area of about 5800 m<sup>2</sup> and features ten galleries. Through clever use of colours, shading and borders, artists have painted directly on to walls to create stunning images that trick one's eye into thinking that animals are smashing through walls, friends are balancing over raging waterfalls, polar bears are trying to steal a sip of coconut drink, etc...

### Day 03 PATTAYA (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, cruise across to Ko Lan (also known as Coral Island) by speedboat to enjoy the sun and sea, beautiful beach as well as popular water activities (optional, at your own expense) such as Water Ski, Para Sailing, Jet Ski, Banana Boat, etc... << **Important Notice : This tour is not applicable to the elderly (60 years and above), physically unfit and/or pregnant passengers as well as infants. Affected passenger(s) may either remain at the hotel until the rest of the passengers return from Coral Island OR spend the morning enjoying the sea, sun and beach along Pattaya Beach where one can stretch out on a deckchair, soak up the sun, or watch an exhilarating banana boat ride >>** Spend the afternoon visiting Moo Baan Chon Pao, a living community attraction that features the Kayan Lahwi, an immigrant tribe from Myanmar where their womenfolk are adorned with heavy brass neck rings at a very young age to elongate their necks and are considered to be the village's great beauty.

### Day 04 PATTAYA / BANGKOK (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, embark on your return journey to Bangkok with a brief stop mid-way at a local market place to enjoy a little shopping for some local delicacies. Thereafter, proceed to Safari World, the only drive thru open zoo in Bangkok, housing rare and endangered species from every part of the world. Next to it, is the Marine Park that offers fun-filled family day with 07 amazing world-class animal shows and action stunt show. Shows include Orang Utan Boxing, Sea Lion Performances, Western Cowboy stunt show, Bird show, Polar Bear feeding, Spy war show (a live action spectacular) as well as Jungle cruises.

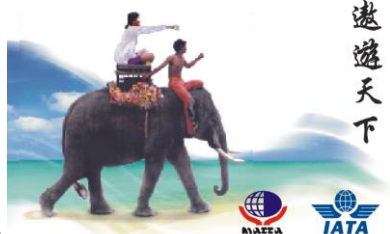
