**Sample itinerary :**

**Day 01** \_\_\_\_\_ / **CHIANG MAI** (Lunch, Dinner)

Upon your arrival in Chiang Mai International Airport, you will be met by our local representative and thereafter, proceed to visit Wat Phrathat Doi Suthep (AD 1384) which contain a holy relic of the Lord Buddha. The pagoda is a symbolic landmark in Chiang Mai with a challenging flight of over 300 steps, flanked by Mythological Nagas. A panoramic view of the city can be seen from here at 3,500 feet above sea level. After lunch, transfer to your selected hotel for check-in and the rest of the day is free at leisure for you to explore the city. In the evening, enjoy a typical Northern Thai-style Dinner followed by a colourful Northern Thai cultural show.

**Day 02** **CHIANG MAI** (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, journey to a lovely wooded setting north of Chiang Mai to visit Maesa Elephant Camp - home to one of the largest assembly of elephants in Northern Thailand. See the talented elephants impress the crowd with their dart shooting skills, show off their dancing skills and play soccer with each other, as well as paint abstracts or pictures with their own unique and distinctive brush strokes. Thereafter, continue on to an orchid farm to view the hundreds species of rare and colourful year-round blooms. In the afternoon, visit several villages that specialize in different local handicrafts including silk weaving, woodcarving, silver and lacquer ware as well as the making of Borsang - paper umbrellas; followed by a little shopping at the World largest Gems Gallery.

**Day 03** **CHIANG MAI / MAE SAI / CHIANG RAI** (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, journey 183 kms to Chiang Rai across mountain valleys and picturesque landscapes with en-route visits to a Hot Spring as well as Wat Rong Khun which is also known as the White Temple. This unique modern temple with its beautiful white ordination hall, *Phra Ubosot* that is decorated with glittering pieces of mirrors, was designed and built by artist Chaloechai Khositphiphat in 1998. Spend some time visiting an Eco-Agricultural Village for an insight into the traditional culture as well as the way of life of various ethnic hill tribes such as Karen - an immigrant tribe from Myanmar where their womenfolk are adorned with heavy brass neck rings at a very young age to elongate their necks; Akha - originated from Tibet more than a century ago, they are the poorest of the hill tribes but well known for their colourful traditional attire; as well as the Yao - also known as Mien, they originated from Southern China and are the only hill tribe to have a written language. Thereafter, drive on to the Golden Triangle Area where the Mekong and Ruak Rivers meet to form the three countries' border (Thai-Laos-Burma) and then to Chiang Saen, the Capital of Ancient Lanna Kingdom during the 12th Century. After lunch, continue on to the bustling Mae Sai Town, the northernmost city at the Thai-Burmese Border for a little sightseeing before returning to Chiang Rai for an overnight stay.

**Day 04** **CHIANG RAI / CHIANG MAI** (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, embark on your return journey back to Chiang Mai across the same mountain route. After lunch, transfer to your selected hotel for check-in and thereafter, rest of the day is free at leisure for your own activities.

**Day 05** **CHIANG MAI / \_\_\_\_\_** (Breakfast)

After breakfast, free at leisure until it is time for your transfer back to the airport for your onwards journey.
