Sample itinerary :

Day 01 _____ / TAOYUAN (No meal)

Upon your arrival in Taoyuan International Airport, you will be met by our local representative for your transfer to the selected hotel at Taoyuan for check-in. Rest of the day is free at leisure for you to explore the city.

Day 02 TAOYUAN / TAIPEI / TAINAN / KAOHSIUNG (Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, start the day with a visit to Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall - a famous and impressive monument erected in memory of Chiang Kai-Shek, the former President of the Republic of China; before embarking on an approximately 360 kilometres Southwest of Taipei to Kaohsiung, Taiwan's second largest city and its largest port. Along the way, take a short break at Tainan, the oldest city on the island and the birthplace of Taiwan to visit Beimen Crystal Church which emulates the architectural visage of St. Laguna Chapel in Guam. Echoing the roof-shell design of Sydney Opera House, this pretty arched structure features large panes of glass and is built over a manmade reflecting pool, making it an attractive spot for photography. Thereafter, enjoy a little shopping at the quaint filming location of the famous 2005 Taiwanese drama "The Prince Who Turns into a Frog", Qian Lai Ye (literally Money Coming) - a perfect little souvenir store where one can find a large array of knick-knacks, nostalgic toys, snacks as well as local delicacies such as the popular salt baked eggs. On arrival at Kaohsiung, enjoy some free time at Taroko Park - an 8.7-hectare venue that combines shopping, dining, sports facilities, a movie theatre, a roller-skating rink as well as an F1-level karting circuit licensed by Suzuka Japan in one single location; before heading over to the famous Liu He Night Market. Albeit small, this 138-stalls night market boasts a very rich display of Southern Taiwanese delicacies.

Day 03 KAOHSIUNG / TAINAN (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, enjoy a little sightseeing around the city visiting Fo Guang Shan Buddha Memorial Centre - home to the last remaining Buddha's tooth relic which was presented by Tibetan Lama Kunga Dorje Rinpoche who has been protecting it after the destruction of its former home in Tibet's Namgyal Monastery; followed by Pearl Cultivation Centre where one can learn about how these exquisite jewels are cultivated and harvested; before returning to Tainan with a stop mid-way to enjoy a walking tour around TianLiao Moon World - a tract of barren land between Chongde Village and Gutin Village that has over the years eroded into bizarre knife-edge ridges, sharp pinnacles as well as graceful, curved arcs. Evening is free at leisure for you to enjoy the respective farm's activities.

Day 04 TAINAN/ NANTOU / CINGJING (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, journey approximately 130 kilometres Northeast of Tainan to visit the Sun Moon Lake National Scenic Area where the island's largest lake is located (lake cruise is optional, on own expense). This beautiful alpine lake is divided by the tiny Lalu Island, an ancient settlement of the Thao people and home of Pashala, their highest-ranking ancestral spirit. The eastern part of the lake is round like the sun while the western part is shaped like a crescent moon, hence, the name "Sun Moon Lake". On the northern shore of the lake, visit the beautiful Wenwu Temple with its "Year of Steps" - a flight of stairs with 366 steps that symbolizes the 366 days of the year, including the extra day in a leap year. Known as the "Stairway to Heaven" in the early days, these steps were the original entrance to the temple. Thereafter, enjoy a little shopping at an aboriginal culture village for some traditional health food and honey bee products; before embarking on an approximately 60-kilometre journey passing native forests and through towering gorges to Cingjing Veterans Farm at an altitude of 1,750 meters above sea level. Immerse yourself in the cool fresh air and scenic wild greenery as well as enjoy the farm's attractions such as the Green Green Grasslands - a wide piece of green grassy plains with azure skies above, verdant mountains in the horizon and herds of sheep grazing as well as roaming freely on the grassy hills; and Cingjing Sheep Castle - a pretty castle-like architecture that is primarily used as a retail area for souvenirs with a sheep pen outside for visitors to mingle or feed the adoring animals.

Day 05 CINGJING/ HSINCHU / TAIPEI / JINSHAN (Breakfast)

After breakfast, visit a Tea Culture Centre to learn about tea production process as well as the art of drinking Taiwanese Tea; before embarking on your journey back to Taipei with a stop mid-way to enjoy a couple of fun-filled hours at Leofoo Village Theme Park - Asia's first large-scale Theme Park that combines both Amusement Park and Wildlife Safari Park. The park features four theme areas, namely African Safari - the only safari zoo in Taiwan that houses over 1000 animals of more than 70 species; Wild West - home to the thrilling "Screaming Corridor", Asia's only U-shaped suspended spiral roller coaster; Arabian Kingdom - a magical Arabian journey where well-known bedtime stories come to life; as well as South Pacific which offers a number of attractions that are suitable for younger kids. Spend the wandering around the streets of Ximending - Taipei's first and the largest pedestrian zone filled with little shops, food stalls, restaurants, cinemas and occasionally, street performances! Popularly known as the "Shibuya of Taipei", the area is also source of Taiwan's fashion as well as alternative culture and features a wide selection of fashionable clothing as well as accessories. Evening is free at leisure for you to explore Jinshan, home to one of the few undersea hot springs in the world; or alternative, enjoy a relaxing soak in a hot spring bath.

Day 06 JINSHAN / TAIPEI**(Breakfast, Lunch)**

After breakfast, enjoy a walking tour around Yuanshan Scenic Area - Taipei City's very first park and home to the famous Grand Hotel. Established in 1897, this 133-hectare urban park is latticed with paved trails and stairways, winding up the hills and past a Buddhist Temple to an observation platform that overlooks Taipei City. Thereafter, enjoy a little shopping for some local delicacies; followed by a visit to Tian Lu Pixiu Culture Centre to learn more about Feng Shui and this mythical animal which is believed to bring wealth as well as good luck; as well as Taipei 101 - the first International Top Brand Shopping Mall in Taiwan where you can find a selection of International Trendy Fashion Brands, Luxury Boutiques as well as Gourmet Food. Taipei 101 also features an indoor as well as outdoor observatory (optional, on own expenses) which offers a 360-degree view of the city. Spend the rest of the afternoon bargain-hunting at the renowned Wufenpu Garment Wholesalers' district which is stuffed to the brim with inexpensive clothing as well as related adornments; before heading over to Raohe Street Tourist Night Market, the oldest Night Market in Taiwan which boasts numerous delicious cuisines and various characteristic snacks which are renowned at home as well as abroad.

Day 07 TAIPEI**(Breakfast, Lunch)**

After breakfast, enjoy a walking tour around Yangmingshan National Park, the only national park in Taiwan that is located close to a metropolitan area. Fondly known as the "Forest in the City" or at times, the "Imperial Garden of Taipei", the park's famous landmark and most photographed attraction is the Flower Clock which broadcasts melodious music every half hour. Thereafter, take a stroll around Shilin Official Residence, the former home of the late President Chiang Kai-Shek which has been restored to an ecological park with tree-lined paths, exquisite rose beds as well as expansive and elegant gardens; followed by a little shopping for some duty-free cosmetics at A-Plus; before continuing on to Tamsui, a laidback waterfront township North of Taipei which boasts many historical attractions and is a popular location for viewing the sunset. Visit the bustling Tamsui Old Street, a pedestrian friendly street with enormous array of food to tuck in as well as souvenirs to bring home. Located further downstream from the town is Tamsui Fisherman's Wharf which offers a boardwalk, chic coffee shops as well as seafood restaurants. In the evening, enjoy some last-minute shopping for local handicrafts, clothing, toys, local snacks, etc... at the famous Shihlin Night Market.

Day 08 TAIPEI / TAOYUAN / _____**(Breakfast)**

After breakfast, free at leisure until it is time to transfer back to the airport for your onwards journey.
