Sample itinerary :

Day 01 _____ / TAOYUAN (No meal)

Upon your arrival in Taoyuan International Airport, you will be met by our local representative for your transfer to the selected hotel at Taoyuan for check-in. Rest of the day is free at leisure for you to explore the city.

Day 02 TAOYUAN / JIUFEN / HUALIEN (Breakfast, Dinner)

After breakfast, start the day with sightseeing tour around the city visiting Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall - a famous and impressive monument erected in memory of Chiang Kai-Shek, the former President of the Republic of China; followed by a little shopping for some local delicacies; before continuing on to visit Yehliu Geopark - a stunning geological landscape as a result of sea erosion and weathering over the years. These rock formations have been given imaginative names based on their shapes. Thereafter, explore the quaint little village of Jiufen, formerly a prosperous gold-mining town on the Northeast Coast of Taipei. With its closely built houses clinging onto the steep mountainsides, Jiufen continue to offer enchanting scenery, unique teahouse and fascinating glimpses into the lifestyles of the past. While you are there, do take the opportunity to sample the popular local delicacies such as the Beef Noodles, Fish Ball Soup as well as Taro and Sweet Potato Balls. Later in the afternoon, journey to Hualien via the longest tunnel in Taiwan - Hsuehshan Tunnel, and passing through the scenic Su-Hua Highway.

Day 03 HUALIEN / TAITUNG (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, proceed on a walking tour around Taroko National Park, one of the eight national parks in Taiwan. Spanning across Taichung, Nantou and Hualien County in the eastern part of Taiwan, the park is famous for its spectacular Taroko Gorge as well as the scenic beauty of Liwu River. Explore Swallow Grotto Trail to enjoy the sights of Liwu River right below, the mysterious potholes on the marble cliff faces as well as the famous rock formation "Chieftain's profile rock" which looks like an Indian chief; and followed by a visit to Eternal Spring Shrine which commemorates those who died during the construction of the Central Cross-Island Highway. Spring water adjacent to the shrine flows all year round, thus making it a significant landmark of scenic beauty on the Central Cross-Island Highway. Next, enjoy a little shopping at a Lingzhi Specialty Centre for some of this precious herbal product which is believed to have medicinal values and can confer longevity; before continuing on to Taitung, nicknamed the "Garden of Taiwan" due to its natural charms and fairytale-like scenic beauty. Explore Sanxiantai - an isolated islet few metres off the coast of Chenggong Township that is connected to the mainland by an iconic eight-arch footbridge and features a network of footpaths which provide great views of unique sea-eroded rock formations well as rare coastal vegetation; followed by a visit to Pisilian - a sleepy little village hugging the Pacific coastline and is home to Amis, Taiwan's largest indigenous tribe who founded the unique Paw Paw Drums, made from abandoned fishing buoys.

Day 04 TAITUNG / KAOHSIUNG (Breakfast)

After breakfast, journey approximately 200 kilometres West of Taitung to Kaohsiung to enjoy a couple of fun-filled hours at E-Da World Theme Park - an Aegean-inspired recreational park featuring Taiwan's first roller coaster ride in a complete pitch-black surrounding as well as the biggest Ferris Wheel; followed by a visit to Fo Guang Shan, literally "Buddha's Light Mountain" - Taiwan's largest Buddhist monastery that is well-known for its prominent landmark of a 36-meter tall golden Amitabha Buddha statue that is surrounded by 480 smaller Buddha statues; before heading over to Ruifeng Night Market - a bustling night market that has been favoured by the locals for over 20 years and offers a wide selection of mouth-watering local delicacies, clothing and accessories as well as a whirl of colourful funfair-style games.



Day 05 KAOHSIUNG / ALISHAN (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, visit a Pearl Cultivation Centre where you can learn about how these exquisite jewels are cultivated and harvested; and thereafter, journey approximately 150 kilometres North of Kaohsiung to Alishan National Scenic Area. Take a break along the way to stroll along Eternity Suspension Bridges which command an excellent view of its surroundings; before continuing on to Alishan Forest Recreational Area which is located approximately 2,200 meters above sea level. Situated at the terminal point of Alishan Forest Railway- one of the only three remaining mountain railways around the world, it has the largest wooden train station in Taiwan with an observatory area where one can appreciate the famous sea of clouds as well as the breathtaking views of sunrise and sunset. Enjoy a short train ride aboard the famous Alishan Forest Railway Train; take a hike to the picturesque Sisters' Pond, passing many interestingly shaped trees and roots such as Love Forever, Elephant Trunk Tree, Three Generation Tree, etc... along the way; as well as visit Shoujhen Temple - the largest temple within the scenic forest park and features a spectacular golden ornate altar along with 10,000 individually lighted miniature Buddha statues.

Day 06 ALISHAN / NANTOU / TAICHUNG (Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, start the day with a visit to Jiji Railway Station - built in 1933, it's the oldest train station in the island that is entirely made out of cypress; followed by a walking tour around Sun Moon Lake National Scenic Area where the island's largest lake is located (lake cruise is optional, on own expense). This beautiful alpine lake is divided by the tiny Lalu Island, an ancient settlement of the Thao people and home of Pashala, their highest-ranking ancestral spirit. The eastern part of the lake is round like the sun while the western part is shaped like a crescent moon, hence, the name "Sun Moon Lake". On the northern shore of the lake, visit the beautiful Wenwu Temple with its "Year of Steps" - a flight of stairs with 366 steps that symbolizes the 366 days of the year, including the extra day in a leap year. Known as the "Stairway to Heaven" in the early days, these steps were the original entrance to the temple. Enjoy a little shopping at an aboriginal culture village for some traditional health food and honey bee products; as well as a Tea Culture Centre to learn about tea production process as well as the art of drinking Taiwanese Tea; before continuing on to Feng Jia Night Market - the largest and most popular night market in Central Taiwan featuring all kinds of mouth-watering and innovative Taiwanese snacks as well as fashionable clothing and accessories.

Day 07 TAICHUNG / TAIPEI (Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, return to Taipei and proceed on a sightseeing tour of The Martyr's Shrine with its magnificent architecture that is similar to Taihe Dian Imperial Palace in Beijing, to view the elaborate hourly guard-changing ceremony; followed by a visit to Tian Lu Pixiu Culture Centre to learn more about Feng Shui and this mythical animal which is believe to bring wealth as well as good luck. Thereafter, continue on to Tamsui, a laidback waterfront township North of Taipei which boasts many historical attractions and is a popular location for viewing the sunset. Visit the bustling Tamsui Old Street, a pedestrian friendly street with enormous array of food to tuck in as well as souvenirs to bring home. Located further downstream from the town is Tamsui Fisherman's Wharf which offers a boardwalk, chic coffee shops as well as seafood restaurants. In the evening, enjoy some last-minute shopping for local handicrafts, clothing, toys, local snacks, etc... at the famous Shihlin Night Market.

Day 08 TAIPEI / TAOYUAN / _____ (Breakfast)

After breakfast, free at leisure until it is time to transfer back to the airport for your onwards journey.
