Sample itinerary :

Day 01 _____ / TAOYUAN

(No meal)

Upon your arrival in Taoyuan International Airport, you will be met by our local representative for your transfer to the selected hotel at Taoyuan for check-in. Rest of the day is free at leisure for you to explore the city.

Day 02 TAOYUAN / TAICHUNG / CINGJING

(Breakfast, Dinner)

After breakfast, begin the day with an approximately 120 kilometres journey southwest of Taoyuan to enjoy a couple of adventurous, thrilling and fun-filled hours at Lihpao Land. Home to Gravity Max, the world's first and only tilt roller coaster that features a 90-degree vertical drop, the park offers everything from facilities for the little kiddies to varied attractions as well as fun rides for older kids and those young at heart. Thereafter, continue approximately 120 kilometres east, passing native forests and through towering gorges, to Cingjing Veterans Farm at an altitude of 1,750 meters above sea level. Immerse yourself in the cool fresh air and scenic wild greenery as well as enjoy the farm's attractions such as the Green Grasslands – a wide piece of green grassy plains with azure skies above, verdant mountains in the horizon and herds of sheep grazing as well as roaming freely on the grassy hills; Cingjing Sheep Castle – a pretty castle-like architecture that is primarily used as a retail area for souvenirs with a sheep pen outside for visitors to mingle or feed the adoring animals; as well as the 1.2-kilometre long Cingjing Skywalk (optional, on own expense) which is located at an altitude of 1,700 – 2,000 meters and has six lookout points, allowing visitors to see the magnificent mountain views and Cingjing Farm below.

Day 03 CINGJING / NANTOU / KAOHSIUNG

(Breakfast, Lunch)

Rise before dawn for a memorable trip to Hehuanshan (optional, on own expense) which boasts spellbinding views, arriving just in time for the most breathtaking sunrise to work its magic. << *Hehuanshan Sunrise Tour requires a 01-day advance reservation and is subjected to weather as well as road conditions. Tour costs approximately TWD\$450.00 per person, payable by cash to guide directly* >> After breakfast, leave Cingjing for Sun Moon Lake National Scenic Area where the island's largest lake is located (lake cruise is optional, on own expense). This beautiful alpine lake is divided by the tiny Lalu Island, an ancient settlement of the Thao people and home of Pashala, their highest-ranking ancestral spirit. The eastern part of the lake is round like the sun while the western part is shaped like a crescent moon, hence, the name "Sun Moon Lake". On the northern shore of the lake, visit the beautiful Wenwu Temple with its "Year of Steps" – a flight of stairs with 366 steps that symbolizes the 366 days of the year, including the extra day in a leap year. Known as the "Stairway to Heaven" in the early days, these steps were the original entrance to the temple. Thereafter, continue an approximately 200 kilometres journey south to Kaohsiung, a thriving metropolis known as "Taiwan's Maritime Capital" at the southern tip of the island. Along the way, visit a Tea Culture Centre to learn about tea production process as well as the art of drinking Taiwanese Tea. Upon arrival, enjoy a little sightseeing around the city visiting Fo Guang Shan, literally "Buddha's Light Mountain" – Taiwan's largest Buddhist monastery that is well-known for its prominent landmark of a 36-meter tall golden Amitabha Buddha statue that is surrounded by 480 smaller Buddha statues; and Pier-2 Art Centre – a complex of old warehouses built in 1973 that has been converted in to exhibition halls as well as artsy boutiques and houses various contemporary art projects throughout the year; before heading over to the famous Liu He Night Market. Albeit small, this 138-stalls night market boasts a very rich display of Southern Taiwanese delicacies.

Day 04 KAOHSIUNG / TAITUNG

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, enjoy a stroll at the tranquil Cheng Cing Lake Scenic Area, the largest man-made lake in Kaohsiung that is originally developed as a reservoir to supply water for industrial use, and features many scenic spots of natural as well as cultural significance such as the 230-metre-long Bridge of Nine Turns, the 43-metre-tall Jhongsing Pagoda, etc...; followed by a visit to Cheng Cing Lake Exotic Marine Life Museum – a massive 200-metre underground bunker that has been remodelled to exhibit oceanic organisms as well as rare sea creatures. Head over to a Pearl Cultivation Centre to learn about how these exquisite jewels are cultivated and harvested before continuing approximately 160 kilometres east to Taitung, nicknamed the "Garden of Taiwan" due to its natural charms and fairytale-like scenic beauty. Along the way, take a breather to visit Douliang Station – dubbed "the most scenic train station in Taiwan", it has ceased operations in 2006 but its viewing platform is still very lively and offers stunning panoramic views of the Pacific Ocean as well as the lush greenery of the surrounding mountains. Evening is free at leisure for you to explore Zhiben, one of the famous and oldest hot spring towns in Taiwan; or alternatively, enjoy a relaxing soak in Zhiben's acclaimed hot springs. << *Please bring along your swimwear as well as swimming cap* >>

Day 05 TAITUNG / HUALIEN

(Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, leave Taitung and head approximately 200 kilometres north to Hualien via the breathtaking East Rift Valley National Scenic Area. Often called the land of milk and honey, it is one of the most fertile and verdant areas on the island, comprising of green fields, tea plantations, orchards, pasture land and of course, the typical Asian rice fields. Take a break along the way at the Tropic of Cancer which marks the Northern Hemisphere's furthest location from Equator where one can experience the unique "shadowless" phenomenon at noon every year during the summer solstice. Upon arrival at Hualien, enjoy a walking tour around Taroko National Park, one of the eight national parks in Taiwan. Spanning across Taichung, Nantou and Hualien County in the eastern part of Taiwan, the park is famous for its spectacular Taroko Gorge as well as the scenic beauty of Liwu River. Explore Swallow Grotto Trail to enjoy the sights of Liwu River right below, the mysterious potholes on the marble cliff faces as well as the famous rock formation "Chieftain's profile rock" which looks like an Indian chief; and followed by a visit to Eternal Spring Shrine which commemorates those who died during the construction of the Central Cross-Island Highway. Spring water adjacent to the shrine flows all year round, thus making it a significant landmark of scenic beauty on the Central Cross-Island Highway. In the evening, visit Dongdamen Tourist Night Market, the largest night market in Hualien which comprises of Futing Night Market where one can find delectable traditional Taiwanese snacks and entertaining street games; Street of China Cuisines that represents cuisines and handicrafts from Guangdong, Guangxi, Hebei, Hunan and Jiangxi Provinces; Street of Indigenous Cuisines with distinctive vibe and is dedicated to Taiwanese aboriginal delicacies and other gifts; as well as Zhiqiang Night Market which was relocated here a little later and features time-honoured stores.

Day 06 HUALIEN / TAIPEI (Breakfast)

After breakfast, journey approximately 180 kilometres north of Hualien, via Hsuehshan Tunnel, the longest tunnel in Taiwan and passing through the scenic Su-Hua Highway, to visit the quaint little village of Jiufen, formerly a prosperous gold-mining town on the Northeast Coast of Taipei. With its closely built houses clinging onto the steep mountainsides, Jiufen continue to offer enchanting scenery, unique teahouse and fascinating glimpses into the lifestyles of the past. While you are there, do take the opportunity to sample the popular local delicacies such as the Beef Noodles, Fish Ball Soup as well as Taro and Sweet Potato Balls. Thereafter, continue on to Taipei for a sightseeing tour around the city visiting Tian Lu Pixiu Culture Centre to learn more about Feng Shui and this mythical animal which is believe to bring wealth as well as good luck; Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall - a famous and impressive monument erected in memory of Chiang Kai-Shek, the former President of the Republic of China; followed by a little shopping for some local delicacies; before heading over to The Martyr's Shrine with its magnificent architecture that is similar to Taihe Dian Imperial Palace in Beijing, to view the elaborate hourly guard-changing ceremony. Later in the evening, enjoy some last-minute shopping for local handicrafts, clothing, toys, local snacks, etc... at the famous Shihlin Night Market.

Day 07 TAIPEI / TAOYUAN / _____ (Breakfast)

After breakfast, free at leisure until it is time to transfer back to the airport for your onwards journey.
