## Sample itinerary :

### Day 01 \_\_\_\_\_ / **TAOYUAN** (No meal)

Upon your arrival in Taoyuan International Airport, you will be met by our local representative for your transfer to the selected hotel at Taoyuan for check-in. Rest of the day is free at leisure for you to explore the city.

### Day 02 **TAOYUAN / TAIPEI / JIUFEN / CINGJING** (Breakfast, Dinner)

After breakfast, begin the day with sightseeing tour around the city visiting Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall - a famous and impressive monument erected in memory of Chiang Kai-Shek, the former President of the Republic of China; followed by a little shopping for some local delicacies; before continuing on to the quaint little village of Jiufen, formerly a prosperous gold-mining town on the Northeast Coast of Taipei. With its closely built houses clinging onto the steep mountainsides, Jiufen continue to offer enchanting scenery, unique teahouse and fascinating glimpses into the lifestyles of the past. While you are there, do take the opportunity to sample the popular local delicacies such as the Beef Noodles, Fish Ball Soup as well as Taro and Sweet Potato Balls. In the afternoon, embark on an approximately 250 kilometres journey south of Jiufen, passing native forests and through towering gorges, to Cingjing Veterans Farm at an altitude of 1,750 meters above sea level.

### Day 03 **CINGJING / NANTOU** (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Rise before dawn for a memorable trip to Hehuanshan (optional, on own expense) which boasts spellbinding views, arriving just in time for the most breathtaking sunrise to work its magic. << *Hehuanshan Sunrise Tour requires a 01-day advance reservation and is subjected to weather as well as road conditions. Tour costs approximately TWD\$450.00 per person, payable by cash to guide directly* >> After breakfast, immerse yourself in the cool fresh air and scenic wild greenery as well as enjoy the farm's attractions such as the Green Green Grasslands - a wide piece of green grassy plains with azure skies above, verdant mountains in the horizon and herds of sheep grazing as well as roaming freely on the grassy hills; Cingjing Sheep Castle - a pretty castle-like architecture that is primarily used as a retail area for souvenirs with a sheep pen outside for visitors to mingle or feed the adoring animals; as well as the 1.2-kilometre long Cingjing Skywalk (optional, on own expense) which is located at an altitude of 1,700 - 2,000 meters and has six lookout points, allowing visitors to see the magnificent mountain views and Cingjing Farm below. Enjoy a little shopping at an aboriginal culture village offering traditional health food and honey bee products; before continuing on to Sun Moon Lake National Scenic Area where the island's largest lake is located (lake cruise is optional, on own expense). This beautiful alpine lake is divided by the tiny Lalu Island, an ancient settlement of the Thao people and home of Pashala, their highest-ranking ancestral spirit. The eastern part of the lake is round like the sun while the western part is shaped like a crescent moon, hence, the name "Sun Moon Lake". On the northern shore of the lake, visit the beautiful Wenwu Temple with its "Year of Steps" - a flight of stairs with 366 steps that symbolizes the 366 days of the year, including the extra day in a leap year. Known as the "Stairway to Heaven" in the early days, these steps were the original entrance to the temple. Thereafter, visit the eye-catching Xiangshan Visitor Center which offers splendid views of Sun Moon Lake from atop a sleek modern structure that is dominated by a touch of zen and in perfect harmony with the its surroundings; followed by a relaxing soak at Dongpu Scenic Area which is renowned for its fantastic hot springs that is clear and drinkable. << *Please bring along your swimwear as well as swimming cap* >>

### Day 04 **NANTOU / CHIAYI / KAOHSIUNG** (Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, depart for Alishan Forest Recreational Area which is located approximately 2,200 meters above sea level. Situated at the terminal point of Alishan Forest Railway - one of the only three remaining mountain railways around the world, it has the largest wooden train station in Taiwan with an observatory area where one can appreciate the famous sea of clouds as well as the breathtaking views of sunrise and sunset. Enjoy a short train ride aboard the famous Alishan Forest Railway Train; take a hike to the picturesque Sisters' Pond, passing many interestingly shaped trees and roots such as Love Forever, Elephant Trunk Tree, Three Generation Tree, etc... along the way; as well as visit Shoujhen Temple - the largest temple within the scenic forest park and features a spectacular golden ornate altar along with 10,000 individually lighted miniature Buddha statues. Thereafter, embark on an approximately 160 kilometres south to Kaohsiung, a thriving metropolis known as "Taiwan's Maritime Capital" at the southern tip of the island. Along the way, visit a Tea Culture Centre to learn about tea production process as well as the art of drinking Taiwanese Tea; enjoy a photo stop at the Tropic of Cancer Monument that cut across Central Taiwan, neatly dividing the temperate zone on the north and tropical zone on the south; before heading over to the famous Liu He Night Market. Albeit small, this 138-stalls night market boasts a very rich display of Southern Taiwanese delicacies.

### Day 05 **KAOHSIUNG / LUKANG / TAICHUNG** (Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, visit a Pearl Cultivation Centre where one can learn about how these exquisite jewels are cultivated and harvested; and Fo Guang Shan Buddha Memorial Centre - home to the last remaining Buddha's tooth relic which was presented by Tibetan Lama Kunga Dorje Rinpoche who has been protecting it after the destruction of its former home in Tibet's Namgyal Monastery. Thereafter, embark on an approximately 200 kilometres journey north of Kaohsiung to Taichung with an enroute stop at Lukang, the second oldest town in Taiwan, to visit Hu Sheng Glass Temple, the world's one and only glass-built Mazu Temple. On arrival at Taichung, enjoy a stroll at Gaomei Wetlands, a grassy and muddy tidal flat where one can catch the sea breeze and watch beautiful sunsets. Take off your shoes and feel the softness of the wetlands between your toes or simply sit back and relax at the sight of the wind turbines on the horizon; before continuing on to Feng Jia Night Market - the largest and most popular night market in Central Taiwan featuring all kinds of mouth-watering and innovative Taiwanese snacks as well as fashionable clothing and accessories.

**Day 06 TAICHUNG / TAIPEI (Breakfast, Lunch)**

After breakfast, return to Taipei for a sightseeing tour of the city, visiting The Martyr's Shrine with its magnificent architecture that is similar to Taihe Dian Imperial Palace in Beijing, to view the elaborate hourly guard-changing ceremony; and Tian Lu Pixiu Culture Centre to learn more about Feng Shui and this mythical animal which is believed to bring wealth as well as good luck. Along the way, enjoy a little shopping for some local delicacies. Thereafter, head over to Tamsui, a laidback waterfront township North of Taipei which boasts many historical attractions and is a popular location for viewing the sunset. Visit the bustling Tamsui Old Street, a pedestrian friendly street with enormous array of food to tuck in as well as souvenirs to bring home. Located further downstream from the town is Tamsui Fisherman's Wharf which offers a boardwalk, chic coffee shops as well as seafood restaurants. Later in the evening, enjoy some last-minute shopping for local handicrafts, clothing, toys, local snacks, etc... at the famous Shihlin Night Market.

**Day 07 TAIPEI / TAOYUAN / \_\_\_\_\_ (Breakfast)**

After breakfast, free at leisure until it is time to transfer back to the airport for your onwards journey.
