## Sample itinerary :

### Day 01 \_\_\_\_\_ / TAOYUAN

(No meal)

Upon your arrival in Taoyuan International Airport, you will be met by our local representative for your transfer to the selected hotel at Taoyuan for check-in. Rest of the day is free at leisure for you to explore the city.

### Day 02 TAOYUAN / PINGXI / JIUFEN / JINSHAN (Breakfast, Dinner)

After breakfast, begin the day with an approximately 70 kilometres journey east of Taoyuan to visit Shifen Old Street – where one can experience lighting sky lanterns (on shared basis) and see the unique scene of trains running right through the old street filled with many houses which still retains the charm of yesteryear, souvenir shops as well as restaurants on both sides of the railway; followed by a walking tour around the quaint little village of Jiufen, formerly a prosperous gold-mining town on the Northeast Coast of Taipei. With its closely built houses clinging onto the steep mountainsides, Jiufen continue to offer enchanting scenery, unique teahouse and fascinating glimpses into the lifestyles of the past. While you are there, do take the opportunity to sample the popular local delicacies such as the Beef Noodles, Fish Ball Soup as well as Taro and Sweet Potato Balls. Thereafter, continue on to Yehliu Geopark – a stunning geological landscape formation as a result of sea erosion and weathering over the years. These rock formations have been given imaginative names based on their shapes such as the iconic "Queen's Head", the cute "Princess Rock", the famous "Fairy's Shoe", etc... Evening is free at leisure for you to explore Jinshan, home to one of the few undersea hot springs in the world; or alternative, enjoy a relaxing soak in a hot spring bath. << Please bring along your swimwear as well as swimming cap >>

### Day 03 JINSHAN / HSINCHU / NANTOU (Breakfast, Dinner)

After breakfast, journey approximately 100 kilometres south of Jinshan to enjoy a couple of fun-filled hours at Leefoo Village Theme Park – Asia's first large-scale Theme Park that combines both Amusement Park and Wildlife Safari Park. The park features four theme areas, namely African Safari – the only safari zoo in Taiwan that houses over 1000 animals of more than 70 species; Wild West – home to the thrilling "Screaming Corridor", Asia's only U-shaped suspended spiral roller coaster; Arabian Kingdom – a magical Arabian journey where well-known bedtime stories come to life; as well as South Pacific which offers a number of attractions that are suitable for younger kids. Thereafter, continue on to visit Chung Tai Chan Monastery which bears a striking resemblance to a mosque and is the second tallest Buddhist architecture in the world; before heading over to explore Tai Yi Ecological Leisure Farm – a 13-hectare park that features a Flower-god Temple, Rainforest Culture Museum, Butterfly Pavilion, Green Sculpture Park, Greenery Square as well as eco-buildings. Wander around the lively park to appreciate the beautiful and colourful sea of flowers; experience seasonal fruit picking; or join some specially designed DIY activities to gain further understandings to ecology and life. << activities at Tai Yi Ecological Leisure Farm are optional, at own expense >>

### Day 04 NANTOU / CHIAYI / TAINAN (Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, enjoy a walking tour around Sun Moon Lake National Scenic Area where the island's largest lake is located. This beautiful alpine lake is divided by the tiny Lalu Island, an ancient settlement of the Thao people and home of Pashala, their highest-ranking ancestral spirit. The eastern part of the lake is round like the sun while the western part is shaped like a crescent moon, hence, the name "Sun Moon Lake". On the northern shore of the lake, visit the beautiful Wenwu Temple with its "Year of Steps" – a flight of stairs with 366 steps that symbolizes the 366 days of the year, including the extra day in a leap year. Known as the "Stairway to Heaven" in the early days, these steps were the original entrance to the temple. Enjoy a little shopping at an aboriginal culture village for some traditional health food and honey bee products; visit a Tea Culture Centre to learn about tea production process as well as the art of drinking Taiwanese Tea; and along the way, take a breather with a photo stop at the Tropic of Cancer Monument that cut across Central Taiwan, neatly dividing the temperate zone on the north and tropical zone on the south. Upon arriving Tainan, the oldest city on the island and the birthplace of Taiwan, take a stroll along Anping Old Street which is packed with little shops and stalls selling local delicacies as well as various products ranging from toys and soaps to trinkets and handbags; before heading over to one the many night markets for an essential dose of Taiwanese cultural experience at the city which is notable for its mouth-watering delicacies.

### Day 05 TAINAN / KAOHSIUNG / TAICHUNG (Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, visit Beimen Crystal Church which emulates the architectural visage of St. Laguna Chapel in Guam. Echoing the roof-shell design of Sydney Opera House, this pretty arched structure features large panes of glass and is built over a manmade reflecting pool, making it an attractive spot for photography. Thereafter, enjoy a little shopping at the quaint filming location of the famous 2005 Taiwanese drama "The Prince Who Turns into a Frog", Qian Lai Ye (literally Money Coming) – a perfect little souvenir store where one can find a large array of knick-knacks, nostalgic toys, snacks as well as local delicacies such as the popular salt baked eggs; before continuing approximately 50 kilometers south of Tainan to Kaohsiung to visit a Pearl Cultivation Centre where one can learn about how these exquisite jewels are cultivated and harvested; as well as Fo Guang Shan Buddha Memorial Centre – home to the last remaining Buddha's tooth relic which was presented by Tibetan Lama Kunga Dorje Rinpoche who has been protecting it after the destruction of its former home in Tibet's Namgyal Monastery. Turn around and head north to Taichung and on arrival, enjoy a stroll around Feng Jia Night Market – the largest and most popular night market in Central Taiwan featuring all kinds of mouth-watering and innovative Taiwanese snacks as well as fashionable clothing and accessories.

**Day 06 TAICHUNG / TAIPEI (Breakfast, Lunch)**

After breakfast, return to Taipei for a sightseeing tour of the city, visiting The Martyr's Shrine with its magnificent architecture that is similar to Taihe Dian Imperial Palace in Beijing, to view the elaborate hourly guard-changing ceremony; Tian Lu Pixiu Culture Centre to learn more about Feng Shui and this mythical animal which is believed to bring wealth as well as good luck; Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall - a famous and impressive monument erected in memory of Chiang Kai-Shek, the former President of the Republic of China; followed by a little shopping for some local delicacies; before spending some free time wandering around the streets of Ximending - Taipei's first and the largest pedestrian zone filled with little shops, food stalls, restaurants, cinemas and occasionally, street performances! Popularly known as the "Shibuya of Taipei", the area is also source of Taiwan's fashion as well as alternative culture and features a wide selection of fashionable clothing as well as accessories. Thereafter, continue on to Taipei 101 - the first International Top Brand Shopping Mall in Taiwan where you can find a selection of International Trendy Fashion Brands, Luxury Boutiques as well as Gourmet Food. Taipei 101 also features an indoor as well as outdoor observatory (on own expenses) which offers a 360-degree view of the city. In the evening, head over to Raohe Street Tourist Night Market, the oldest Night Market in Taiwan which boasts numerous delicious cuisines and various characteristic snacks which are renowned at home and abroad.

**Day 07 TAIPEI / TAOYUAN / \_\_\_\_\_ (Breakfast)**

After breakfast, free at leisure until it is time to transfer back to the airport for your onwards journey.
