Day 01 _____ / TAOYUAN

(No meal)

Upon your arrival in Taoyuan International Airport, you will be met by our local representative for your transfer to the selected hotel at Taoyuan for check-in. Rest of the day is free at leisure for you to explore the city.

Day 02 TAOYUAN / MIAOLI / TAINAN

(Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, embark on an approximately 280 kilometres journey south of Taoyuan to Tainan, the oldest city on the island and the birthplace of Taiwan. Along the way, take a breather at Houlong Cape of Good Hope which is located on a sea front hill that boast stunning vistas of an infinite ocean of ebbing and flowing waves, a continuous coastal bay that spans several kilometres on one side as well as layers and layers of verdant mountains on the other. On arrival at Tainan, enjoy a stroll along Anping Old Street which is packed with little shops and stalls selling local delicacies as well as various products ranging from toys and soaps to trinkets and handbags; followed by a visit to Beimen Crystal Church which emulates the architectural visage of St. Laguna Chapel in Guam. Echoing the roof-shell design of Sydney Opera House, this pretty arched structure features large panes of glass and is built over a manmade reflecting pool, making it an attractive spot for photography. Thereafter, enjoy a little shopping at the quaint filming location of the famous 2005 Taiwanese drama "The Prince Who Turns into a Frog", Qian Lai Ye (literally Money Coming) – a perfect little souvenir store where one can find a large array of knick-knacks, nostalgic toys, snacks as well as local delicacies such as the popular salt baked eggs; before heading over to one the many night markets for an essential dose of Taiwanese cultural experience at the city which is notable for its mouth-watering delicacies

Day 03 TAINAN / KAOHSIUNG

(Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, continue approximately 50 kilometers south of Tainan to Kaohsiung, a thriving metropolis known as "Taiwan's Maritime Capital" at the southern tip of the island. Upon arrival, begin with a little sightseeing around the city visiting Fo Guang Shan Buddha Memorial Centre – home to the last remaining Buddha's tooth relic which was presented by Tibetan Lama Kunga Dorje Rinpoche who has been protecting it after the destruction of its former home in Tibet's Namgyal Monastery; and a Pearl Cultivation Centre where one can learn about how these exquisite jewels are cultivated and harvested. Spend by some free time to exploring Taroko Park – an 8.7-hectare venue that combines shopping, dining, sports facilities, a movie theatre. a roller-skating rink along with an F1-level karting circuit licensed by Suzuka Japan in one single location; as well as Pier-2 Art Centre – a complex of old warehouses built in 1973 that has been converted in to exhibition halls as well as artsy boutiques and houses various contemporary art projects throughout the year. Thereafter, enjoy a little shopping at Shinkuchan Commercial District which is renowned for its wide array of local and overseas fashionable clothing, accessories as well as special designer products; followed by a walk around Ruifeng Night Market – a bustling night market that has been favoured by the locals for over 20 years and offers a wide selection of mouth-watering local delicacies, clothing and accessories as well as a whirl of colourful funfair-style games.

Day 04 KAOHSIUNG / NANTOU / TAICHUNG

(Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, journey approximately 200 kilometres North of Kaohsiung to the Sun Moon Lake National Scenic Area where the island's largest lake is located (lake cruise is optional, on own expense). This beautiful alpine lake is divided by the tiny Lalu Island, an ancient settlement of the Thao people and home of Pashala, their highest-ranking ancestral spirit. The eastern part of the lake is round like the sun while the western part is shaped like a crescent moon, hence, the name "Sun Moon Lake". On the northern shore of the lake, visit the beautiful Wenwu Temple with its "Year of Steps" – a flight of stairs with 366 steps that symbolizes the 366 days of the year, including the extra day in a leap year. Known as the "Stairway to Heaven" in the early days, these steps were the original entrance to the temple. Thereafter, continue on to Taichung with enroute stops along the way to enjoy a little shopping at an aboriginal culture village that offers traditional health food and honey bee products; as well as visit a Tea Culture Centre to learn about tea production process as well as the art of drinking Taiwanese Tea. On arrival at Taichung, enjoy a stroll at Gaomei Wetlands, a grassy and muddy tidal flat where one can catch the sea breeze and watch beautiful sunsets. Take off your shoes and feel the softness of the wetlands between your toes or simply sit back and relax at the sight of the wind turbines on the horizon; before heading over to Feng Jia Night Market – the largest and most popular night market in Central Taiwan featuring all kinds of mouth-watering and innovative Taiwanese snacks as well as fashionable clothing and accessories.

Day 05 TAICHUNG / TAIPEI / JINSHAN

(Breakfast, Dinner)

After breakfast, return to Taipei for a sightseeing tour of the city visiting Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall - a famous and impressive monument erected in memory of Chiang Kai-Shek, the former President of the Republic of China; followed by a little shopping for some local delicacies; before continuing on to the quaint little village of Jiufen, formerly a prosperous gold-mining town east of Taipei. With its closely built houses clinging onto the steep mountainsides, Jiufen continue to offer enchanting scenery, unique teahouse and fascinating glimpses into the lifestyles of the past. While you are there, do take the opportunity to sample the popular local delicacies such as the Beef Noodles, Fish Ball Soup as well as Taro and Sweet Potato Balls. Thereafter, leave Jiufen on a short journey to Jinshan on the northeast coast of Taiwan that is famed for its beautiful coastline sceneries. Browse along the narrow, 300-meter-long Jinshan Old Street - also known as Jinbaoli Old Street, it was a bustling commercial street during the Qing dynasty and is the oldest street in Jinshan. Strolling down this 300-year-old street which is lined with vendors and shops on both sides, one can see vestiges of the area's past heydays and savor the taste of age-old, popular delicacies as well as local specialties such as taro cakes, roasted red heart sweet potatoes, ice-roasted sweet potatoes, candied sweet potatoes, etc... Evening is free at leisure for you to explore Jinshan, home to one of the few undersea hot springs in the world; or alternative, enjoy a relaxing soak in a hot spring bath. << Please bring along your swimwear as well as swimming cap >>



Day 06 JINSHAN / TAIPEI (Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, start the day with a visit to The Martyr's Shrine with its magnificent architecture that is similar to Taihe Dian Imperial Palace in Beijing, to view the elaborate hourly guard-changing ceremony; followed by Tian Lu Pixiu Culture Centre to learn more about Feng Shui and this mythical animal which is believed to bring wealth as well as good luck. Thereafter, head over to Tamsui, a laidback waterfront township North of Taipei which boasts many historical attractions and is a popular location for viewing the sunset. Visit the bustling Tamsui Old Street, a pedestrian friendly street with enormous array of food to tuck in as well as souvenirs to bring home. Located further downstream from the town is Tamsui Fisherman's Wharf which offers a boardwalk, chic coffee shops as well as seafood restaurants. Later in the evening, enjoy some last-minute shopping for local handicrafts, clothing, toys, local snacks, etc... at the famous Shihlin Night Market.

Day 07 TAIPEI / TAOYUAN / _____ (Breakfast)

After breakfast, free at leisure until it is time to transfer back to the airport for your onwards journey.
