Sample itinerary :

Day 01 _____ / DA NANG / HOI AN (Lunch, Dinner)

Upon your arrival at Da Nang International Airport, you will be met by our local representative and thereafter, proceed on a sightseeing tour around the city visiting Marble Mountains - a cluster of five limestone hill formations named after the five natural elements of water, wood, fire, gold as well as earth, and is home to quite a number of Buddhist sanctuaries; followed by Linh Ung Pagoda which boasts a fine array of white marble statues and dominated by a serene 67-meter-tall Goddess of Mercy. Built on the eastern slope of Son Tra Mountain and overlooking the South China Sea, it commands breathtaking views of the boundless sea with bobbing boats and Cham Islands in the distance as well as the panoramic views of Da Nang city below. In the evening, enjoy a little shopping at Big C and Han Market which offers a wide variety of fresh food, local delicacies as well as clothing and souvenirs; before heading Southeast to Hoi An, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and an exceptionally well-preserved example of a South-East Asian trading port dating from the 15th to the 19th century. Its buildings and its street plan reflect the influences, a blend of both indigenous and foreign to produce this unique heritage site.

Day 02 HOI AN / QUANG NAM / HOI AN (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, journey approximately 40 kilometres West of Hoi An to My Son Holy Land, a UNESCO World Heritage Site in Central Vietnam. Formerly an imperial city during the Cham Dynasty between the 4th and 13th century, My Son Sanctuary is a large temple complex that comprises of more than 70 architectural works, derived from the cultural and spiritual influences from Indian Hinduism. However, due to natural disasters and war-related damages, only about 20 temple towers still remain. Thereafter, return to Hoi An for a walking tour around this picturesque ancient town to discover its sleepy charm with its well-preserved quaint wooden houses, Chinese Assembly Halls, temples and rich merchants' houses of the past as well as the 16th century Japanese Covered Bridge. Evening is free at leisure for you to explore this story book town.

Day 03 HOI AN / BA NA HILLS / DA NANG (Breakfast)

After an early breakfast, head Northwest to the scenic resort village of Ba Na Hills which is situated 1,487 meters above sea level on Truong Son Mountains. Established in 1919, the resort area once held 200-odd villas but only a few ruins remain. Enjoy a ride on one of the world's longest and highest cable car route while enjoying the spectacular scenery stretching across the green Vietnamese countryside and rice fields to Da Nang City and the East Vietnam Sea. Ride on the funicular to visit Le Jardin d'Amour - a romantic garden with 09 unique architectural style and colourful space; explore Debay Wine Cellar - an ancient cellar dug deep into the mountain that is home to an abundance of grape wines; as well as admire the majestic statue of Shakyamuni at Linh Ung Pagoda; before returning to Da Nang city in the early evening.

Day 04 DA NANG / HUE / DA NANG (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, journey approximately 110 kilometres Northwest of Da Nang to Hue via the 21-kilometers long Hai Van Pass. Also known as the "Ocean Clouds Pass", it is one of the most scenic hillside roads in Vietnam that had once served as a boundary between the Kingdoms of Dai Viet and Champa. Begin with a visit to Thien Mu Pagoda which is located on Ha Khe Hill at the northern bank of Perfume River. The most striking feature of the pagoda is Thap Phuoc Duyen, a 21-meter octagonal tower with seven successive tiers, each of which is dedicated to a human form taken by Buddha. Thereafter, continue on to visit Tomb of Tu Duc - one of the most beautifully designed complexes among the royal palaces and tombs of the Nguyen Dynasty. Embedded in a lush pine forest, this tomb is the final resting place of Emperor Tu Duc who was the longest reigning emperor of the Nguyen Dynasty. After lunch, enjoy a walking tour around Hue's Imperial Citadel, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and home as well as the seat of power for the Nguyen Dynasty (Vietnam's last royal dynasty) from 1803 to 1945. In the heart of the citadel lies the Imperial City which is also known as the "Purple Forbidden City" in Vietnamese, where only the emperor, concubines and members of the royal household as well as those close enough to them were granted access. After dinner, return to Da Nang and rest of the evening is free at leisure for your own activities.

Day 05 DA NANG / _____ (Breakfast)

After breakfast, free at leisure until it is time for your transfer back to the airport for your onwards journey.
