## Sample itinerary :

### Day 01 \_\_\_\_\_ / HANOI

(Lunch, Dinner)

Upon your arrival at Noi Bai International Airport and after clearing customs, please proceed to the Meeting Point area at "Gate A2" at the arrival hall of Terminal 2 to meet our local representative and thereafter, proceed on a sightseeing tour around the city visiting Ba Dinh Square - where president Ho Chi Minh declared the independence of Vietnam on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 1945; Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum - a large memorial and final resting place of Vietnam leader Ho Chi Minh; the 300-foot path called "Mango Alley" that leads to the famous Uncle Ho's House on Stilt - a simple traditional timber cottage in a lovely garden setting where Ho Chi Minh lived and worked in most of his revolutionary life; Presidential Palace - a grand colonial building that houses the living and working headquarters for the French Governor General of Indochina; One Pillar Pagoda - a little temple built of wood on a single stone pillar that resembles a lotus blossom rising from the centre of an elegant square-shaped lotus pond; Temple of Literature - built in the 11th century as Vietnam's first university; as well as Trần Quốc Pagoda - the city's oldest temple located in a picturesque spot on a small island in Hanoi's West Lake. Along the way, enjoy photo stops at Hanoi Opera House - one of the most famous architectural landmarks of Hanoi; Saint Joseph Cathedral - Hanoi's oldest Roman Catholic Church which was completed in 1886 and emulate the architectural visage of the famous Notre Dame in Paris; as well as the scenic Hoàn Kiếm Lake. Before dinner, wander, explore as well as enjoy a little shopping around Hanoi Old Quarter - a maze of quaint narrow streets dating back to the 13<sup>th</sup> century, each named after the craft or goods that was specifically traded there.

### Day 02 HANOI / LÀO CAI

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After an early breakfast, embark on an approximately 350 kilometres' journey Northwest of Hanoi via Nội Bài-Lào Cai Highway to Sapa, a picturesque town nestled on Hoàng Liên Sơn mountain range, close to the Chinese border. Once a French hill station, this 100-year old resort town is home to a number of ethnic minority communities and overlooks a plunging valley of cascading rice terraces that spill down the mountains like patchwork quilt with enigmatic mists that often shroud its hillsides. After lunch, enjoy a short and easy walk downhill through cobble-stoned paved trail to Cat Cat Village, home to the Black Hmong minorities who wears very dark clothing in blacks and navy dyed with indigo. Nestled in the beautiful Muong Hoa Valley and near the stunning Cat Cat Waterfall, this age-old village is famed for retaining its distinctive customs and practices that are lost in most ethnic villages. Explore the magnificent valley, enjoy its breathtaking landscapes, learn the indigenous people's local way of life as well as experience the well preserved traditional handicraft activities such as cotton cultivation and fabric weaving. Evening is free at leisure for you to explore the cool and misty highland, located approximately 1,600 meters above sea level.

### Day 03 LÀO CAI / HANOI

(Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast, start the day with a visit to Ham Rong Mountain, a small mountain approximately 1,800 meters above the town of Sapa that houses a Rock Garden, Orchid Garden as well as a mini museum where artefacts from about 10 tribal groups are displayed in traditional style houses. Take a hike up the long winding cobblestone walkway and see small streams lazily running through nearby bushy foliage along the way; take a breather mid-way to rest your legs and explore a small orchid garden with a charming collection of Sapa's wild orchid; as well as conquer San May "Cloud Yard" at the peak of Ham Rong Mountain to enjoy the panorama of the romantic Sapa town and Fansipan, the highest mountain in Vietnam. After lunch, free at leisure for you to explore the town until it is time for you to embark on your return journey back to Hanoi.

### Day 04 HANOI / \_\_\_\_\_

(Breakfast)

After breakfast, free at leisure until it is time for your transfer back to the airport for your onwards journey.
