## Sample itinerary :

### Day 01 \_\_\_\_\_ / HANOI (Lunch, Dinner)

Upon your arrival at Noi Bai International Airport and after clearing customs, please proceed to the Meeting Point area at "Gate A2" at the arrival hall of Terminal 2 to meet our local representative and thereafter, proceed on a sightseeing tour around the city visiting Ba Dinh Square - where president Ho Chi Minh declared the independence of Vietnam on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 1945; Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum - a large memorial and final resting place of Vietnam leader Ho Chi Minh; the 300-foot path called "Mango Alley" that leads to the famous Uncle Ho's House on Stilt - a simple traditional timber cottage in a lovely garden setting where Ho Chi Minh lived and worked in most of his revolutionary life; Presidential Palace - a grand colonial building that houses the living and working headquarters for the French Governor General of Indochina; One Pillar Pagoda - a little temple built of wood on a single stone pillar that resembles a lotus blossom rising from the centre of an elegant square-shaped lotus pond; Temple of Literature - built in the 11<sup>th</sup> century as Vietnam's first university; as well as Trấn Quốc Pagoda - the city's oldest temple located in a picturesque spot on a small island in Hanoi's West Lake. Along the way, enjoy photo stops at Hanoi Opera House - one of the most famous architectural landmarks of Hanoi; Saint Joseph Cathedral - Hanoi's oldest Roman Catholic Church which was completed in 1886 and emulate the architectural visage of the famous Notre Dame in Paris; as well as the scenic Hoàn Kiếm Lake. Before dinner, wander, explore as well as enjoy a little shopping around Hanoi Old Quarter - a maze of quaint narrow streets dating back to the 13<sup>th</sup> century, each named after the craft or goods that was specifically traded there.

### Day 02 HANOI / NINH BINH / HANOI (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, journey approximately 90 kilometres South of Hanoi to Hoa Lu - the legendary ancient royal capital of Vietnam from 968 to 1009 under the reign of Dinh Dynasty and the early Le Dynasty. Visit the two famous temples which were built in the 11<sup>th</sup> century as a dedication to King Dinh Tien Hoang and his successor, King Le Dai Hanh. Dinh Tien Hoang temple is a unique example of 17<sup>th</sup> century wooden Vietnamese architecture while Le Dai Hanh Temple which stands approximately 500 meters away is similar but smaller in scale. Thereafter, continue on to visit Bich Dong Pagoda - a combination of three pagodas on the Lower, Middle and Upper levels, built on a pretty limestone mountain. After lunch, enjoy a picturesque boat ride around Trang An Ecological Tourist Site to explore the mysterious fairy tale-like waterways with its contrasting forested limestone karst peaks and network of caves with beautiful stalactites. Often referred to as the "Halong Bay on Land", the area is dominated by rice fields as well as limestone rock formations similar to those at Halong Bay but viewed from a winding stream instead of the sea.

### Day 03 HANOI / HA LONG (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, journey 180 kilometers East of Hanoi to Tuan Chau Marina at Ha Long for check-in on board your selected cruise. While lunch is served, set sail through the magical bay where thousands of sculpted limestone islands rise from the waves like dragons' teeth. After lunch, explore Hang Sung Sôt or Surprise Grotto - one of the largest and most spectacular grottoes at Ha Long Bay. Covering an area of 10,000 m<sup>2</sup>, the cave is partitioned into two chambers; the first being similar to a wide theatre hall with many stalactites hanging from the high ceiling. A narrow passage leads to the second chamber where light filtering through a large opening from above creates a natural skylight that bathes the surfaces. At the deepest point of this chamber is a "royal garden" with a clear pond as well as fascinating landscape of small mountains. Thereafter, on a kayak (optional, on own expense) or a bamboo row boat, visit Tung Sau Pearl Farm where these exquisite jewels are cultivated and harvested; as well as explore Luon Cave with its tranquil emerald lake surrounded by luxuriant trees and imposing stone cliff where one can still find traces of fresh water snail fossils. In the evening, enjoy a complimentary cooking demonstration or just unwind with the recreation activities on board.

### Day 04 HA LONG / HANOI (Breakfast, Brunch, Dinner)

Rise to the sound of the ocean coming to life at the dawn of another lovely day. Take the opportunity to view the sunrise over Ha Long Bay while learning Tai Chi on the sundeck. While light refreshment is served, set sail to Titop Island for some swimming or snorkeling at its crescent-shaped beach which is well known for its clean white sand and clear waters as well as alluring landscape. Here, you can also climb the 427 winding steps up to the pagoda-styled lookout point at its peak for an incredible 360-degree view of Halong Bay. Cruise back to the wharf for disembarkation while enjoying your breakfast and after an early lunch at 1958 Restaurant, proceed on your return journey back to Hanoi. Evening is free at leisure for your own activities.



**Day 05 HANOI / \_\_\_\_\_ (Breakfast)**

After breakfast, free at leisure until it is time for your transfer back to the airport for your onwards journey.
